Preparing for 2017-2018

Important Financial Information to Consider ...

- CPI-U for 2017-2018 is 1.26%
 - > This is the 4th Year in a Row Below 2%.
 - 2017-2018 ... **1.26**%
 - 2016-2017 ... **0.12**%
 - 2015-2016 ... **1.62**%
 - 2014-2015 ... **1.46**%
 - 2013-2014 ... 2.00%
 - 2012-2013 ... 2.00%



The "2% Tax Cap"

- Reminder: It is not a Property Tax Cap and it is typically not 2%.
 - In fact, it is only a threshold controlling the allowable increase to the Tax Levy.
 - Controlled by factors such as:
 - * Tax Base Growth Factor (this year 1.0024)
 - * Allowable Levy Growth Factor (Lesser of 2% or CPI-U)
 - **PILOTS** (Payments in Lieu of Taxes)
 - Capital Tax Levy (Includes Current Year Projects and Debt Payments)
 - * TRS and/or ERS Exclusions (None for 2017 / 2018)
