- Meeting was called to order
- II. Krupa explained purpose of the SLC. Some of the items discussed were:
  - a. enhance funding to the district by lobbying Local, State and Federal entities.
  - b. Build partnerships with elected officials
  - c. Engaging the Community
  - d. Make recommendations under the advisement of Dorothy Roberts to help bring positive changes

- V. The honorable Assemblyman Doug Smith was in attendance to explain the Smart School Bond Act and where Sachem was in the process
  - a. Created in 2014- with \$2.5B funding the bond through NYS taxes.
  - b. 2015 money was supposed to become available.
  - c. A Committee is supposed to meet quarterly to review plans.
  - d. Rules are not written clearly for how funding would work for public and private schools within the same district.
  - e. Rules were changed to include school security in the grant application.
  - f. Just over \$400M has been released to date.
  - g. Sachem SD's applied for \$11M which includes security and technology upgrades.
  - h. Assemblyman Smith has created an online position that he is asking for us all to share. Click <u>here</u> for petition.
  - i. Money spent prior to receiving funds through the bond will not be reimbursed.
  - j. Sachem was told in August that they had to reapply under a new test system application.
