We would like to inform you that we have recently received information about a confirmed case of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) with one student at Chippewa. Cleaning and disinfecting of the exposed locations have been completed. As the COVID-19 situation in our country and our community is rapidly evolving, we urge you to take all necessary precautions to limit coronavirus spread in our community.


How You Can Help

Be proactive about reducing the number of interactions that students and staff have with one another by practicing physical distancing (staying at least 6 feet apart) to limit the spread of the coronavirus. In addition to physical distancing, another important tool to prevent the spread of coronavirus is to practice good hygiene. Important public health prevention messages include:

- Stay home when you are sick. Anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 should remain at home in isolation for a minimum of 10 days plus at least 24 hours after the resolution of fever (without fever-reducing medication) and improvement in other symptoms.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Sing the Happy Birthday song to help know when it has been 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use alcoholbased hand sanitizers that contain at least 60% alcohol.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and clean your hands immediately. If you do not have a tissue, use your elbow, not your hands, to cover your coughs and sneezes.
- Limit close contact with people who are sick, and avoid sharing food, drinks, or utensils.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or bactericidal wipes.

- Anyone on school grounds must wear an approved mask.
- If you have been personally notified by the school or the
 Department of Health In order to return to school after a
 suspected case of or known exposure to COVID-19 a negative
 Covid test is required per NYSDOH. If your physician does not feel
 you had COVID-19, a note supporting that fact must be supplied
 by the physician.

Health screening of students and staff for COVID-19 which includes completing a questionnaire about symptoms consistent with COVID-19 illness and a temperature check prior to entering the facility is mandatory in order to help keep our educational setting safe.

Public Health Actions

All confirmed cases should be isolated and close contacts quarantined for 14 days from last exposure in order to prevent illness in new persons. "Close contact" means being a household member, intimate contact, or caregiver of a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case; within 6 feet of the confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case for more than 15 minutes, even if wearing a non-medical face covering; or having unprotected contact with the infected person's body fluids and/or secretions, for example, being coughed or sneezed on.

Please note that all information, including the name(s) of ill persons, shared regarding any Public Health investigation is confidential in order to protect patient privacy.
