WHAT IS HAPPENING AT LYNWOOD?



CLASS 4-3 HAS BEEN ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN THEIR SCIENCE UNIT ON PLANT AND ANIMAL STRUCTURES. THIS WEEK, STUDENTS EXPLORED THE FASCINATING ADAPTATIONS OF THE ASSASSIN BUG, FOCUSING ON THE UNIQUE STRUCTURES IT RELIES ON FOR SURVIVAL.

TO DEEPEN THEIR UNDERSTANDING, STUDENTS TOOK ON AN EXCITING HANDS-ON CHALLENGE—DESIGNING AND CREATING A MODEL OF THE ASSASSIN BUG'S BEAK USING SPECIFIC MATERIALS. ONCE THEIR BEAKS WERE CONSTRUCTED, THEY PUT THEM TO THE TEST BY ATTEMPTING TO EXTRACT THE CONTENTS OF VARIOUS FOOD ITEMS, MIMICKING HOW THE ASSASSIN BUG FEEDS. USING A STRAW, THEY WORKED TO REACH THE CENTER AND REMOVE WHAT WAS INSIDE, JUST AS THE INSECT WOULD IN NATURE.

THE STUDENTS WERE HIGHLY ENGAGED AND ENTHUSIASTIC THROUGHOUT THE ACTIVITY, APPLYING THEIR KNOWLEDGE IN A CREATIVE AND INTERACTIVE WAY. THIS CHALLENGE NOT ONLY REINFORCED THE IMPORTANCE OF STRUCTURAL ADAPTATIONS BUT ALSO ENCOURAGED CRITICAL THINKING AND PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS. IT WAS A GREAT WEEK OF DISCOVERY AND HANDS-ON LEARNING IN CLASS 4-3!

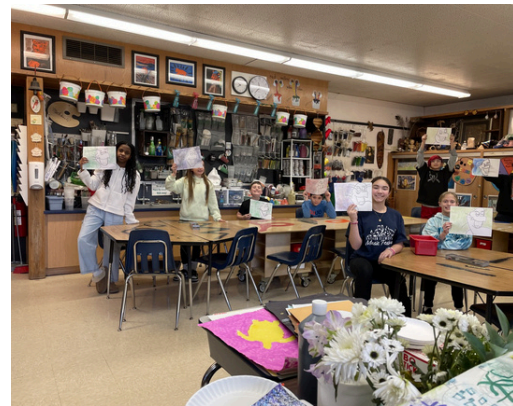
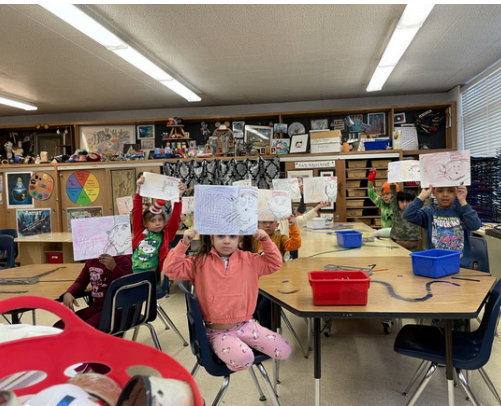
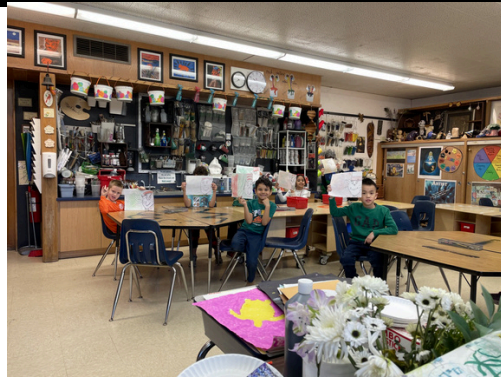
