Book Buddies sharing the love of learning!




Class 1-1 made Kazoos and felt the vibrations that sound makes.





The ENL 2nd graders studied autumn leaves and how the trees change through the seasons! They ended their unit by creating a fun 3D tree diagram!




CLASS 1-4 EXPLORING LIGHT ENERGY WITH PRISMS AND MAKING SHADOWS.
