Technology Update

With the evolution of technology, educational capabilities are rapidly growing and changing on a daily basis. Technology has the ability to further the connection between teachers and students and facilitates peer collaboration. This is why our district has placed a focus on the expansion and integration of technology in our classrooms.

The passage of the 2017-18 budget included technology improvements to further our advancement in connecting our students and teachers to today's digital world of teaching and learning. You can read more about these improvements below.

New Mac Labs at the High Schools

Over the summer, the district updated the computers in our Mac Labs at both high schools, as well as moved pre-existing computers, to create labs at all three middle schools. Students in the Middle Schools are working with these computers in the music program.

High school students use the Macs to learn graphic design, marketing design, Photoshop, photo and video publishing, and game design. They have the opportunity to explore Adobe Suite programs such as Illustrator, where they create detailed vector images, and Photoshop and iMovie, which teach them editing skills.








3-D Printers

3-D printers at both high schools, allow students to take an idea through a design and production process in order to complete a model. They can design their model digitally, and after testing and analyzing a printed prototype, make modifications to improve upon the design. This helps students work through the trial-and-error process, giving them the opportunity to understand how and why their idea worked.

So far this year, students designed custom name plates and their own functional fidget spinners. Additional printers and 3D scanners are planned to further enhance these opportunities at all school levels.






BrightLink Projectors

Currently, the district is in the process of installing more than 80 interactive BrightLink projectors in classrooms districtwide. These new, fully integrated solutions turn existing whiteboards and blank walls into interactive workspaces.

Teachers and students will have the ability to collaborate during a lesson, interact with a computer, and annotate and draw using stylus pens or their fingers.



Breakout EDU

Teachers in our schools have been exploring Breakout EDU, an immersive games platform for learners of all ages. Students work collaboratively in teams to solve a series of problems in order to open a locked box.

Breakout EDU games create an interest level in students where they use their minds and learn important skills for success in school and beyond.







Google Expeditions

The district is working with Eastern Suffolk BOCES to pilot Google Expedition VR system, where students go on virtual expeditions all over the world.


