Technology Upgrades Enhance Curriculum Connections

As technology continues to advance at incredible speed, the proactive integration of educational technology in the classroom is an area of

monumental importance. With this reality in mind, the Sachem Central School District has implemented progressive technology initiatives that enhance the availability of educational technologies to our students.



This year, in all 10 of our

elementary buildings, each individual grade level has received a laptop cart containing 30 computers that also function as touchscreen tablets. Each of the 1,800 Google-compatible devices across the district is equipped with the latest Microsoft Windows software and possesses the ability to connect to countless academic software programs to support student learning.

Utilizing Google Classroom, elementary educators can efficiently share curriculum content to each device as students continue work on class assignments. The expansive Google Suite allows educators to provide real-time feedback on student progress and seamlessly distribute information on

upcoming classroom activities. Additionally, students use programs such as Google Slides to design projects incorporating graphics and text, lending a creative connection to essential curriculum topics.



With the addition of these

devices, numerous programs and software applications are used to complement traditional classroom instruction across content areas. For kindergarten students, the inclusion of the computers acts as an introduction to basic computer functionality and keyboarding.

With programs such as the SMART lab suite, teachers can create engaging educational games that connect to a current area of study. Utilizing Reading A-Z, students have access to a wide variety of interactive and downloadable e-books that challenge students to work up to their ability. At the conclusion of each e-book, students can record themselves reading so teachers can easily monitor the progress of the individual student. Continuing to complement classroom instruction, the educational math website Zearn reinforces math concepts with targeted lessons to support individualized learning.

As we progress throughout the school year, professional development opportunities will be available to our educators on best-practice techniques for effectively implementing and advancing the use of these educational technologies in classroom instruction.
