Career and Technical Education Update



The Sachem Central School District is committed to the continued development and implementation of a well-rounded career and technical education program. This commitment has only strengthened amid the ever-evolving landscape of educational programs and career opportunities available to our students upon graduation.

To this end, the district has established a Career and Technical Education Team composed of our director of guidance and guidance chairs, instructional directors, building administrators, CTE chairs, a work-based learning liaison and a CTE Planning Team, led by members of our family and consumer science, technology and business departments. Assembled as part of the district's multifaceted approach to bolstering CTE opportunities, the team will review current practices and establish initiatives to enhance student experiences.

Events are being planned at the elementary level to introduce the district's younger students to future careers as they embark on their educational

journeys. In addition, the current career folders have been revised to identify learning strengths and initiate a career interest inventory.

At the secondary level, the CTE Team will visit middle schools in neighboring school districts to gain insight into successful CTE programs and how to effectively align middle school CTE courses with our current high school pathways. We will continue to host our Career Connection events at each of our high school buildings, which have featured representatives from more than 30 businesses and organizations to educate students on their careers, career pathways and some of the work-based learning opportunities available to them. Additionally, we will further review our robust CTE offerings currently in place, which include cosmetology, accounting and law, computer repair, carpentry and education, and look at additional pathways to serve a diverse range of student interests.


