Dear Sachem Community,

As a follow up, we'd like to remind you that **Distance Learning** instruction begins on *Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020*.

To streamline the process for families, we have put together a **Google Folder** that will work as a starting point to find all resources provided. This includes location of teacher materials, online resources and department news. All resources can be found using the link below:

The learning experiences that have been created will be updated weekly for students, or in some cases, daily. More specifically:

- Elementary Gr K-5: ELA and Math lessons will be posted for each day of the week. Special Area classes, such as Physical Education, will post one lesson a week.
- Secondary Gr 6-12: Lessons will be posted according to your child's schedule.

You can also expect to receive communication from your child's teacher(s) throughout this time. Do not hesitate to contact them with any questions.

*Should your child receive additional support such as Special Education or English as a Second Language (ESL), lessons will continue to be posted according to the frequency of their current schedule. Our students who receive related services will be hearing directly from their teachers and service providers. These lessons and activities will come directly from their teacher's Google classroom or emails.*


Lastly, please note that our lessons were not designed to run in "real time." Students have the flexibility to complete work according to their family's schedules. We are aware many parents/guardians are now working from home. School assignments, on top of encouraged independent reading, outdoor play and other associated activities can round out a typical day.

Again, we would like to thank you for your patience during this time. We know this will not be able to take the place of full instruction that normally occurs, but know that our teachers and administrators will continue to work tirelessly during our closure.

Dear Sachem Families:

### Child Care Information for Children Ages 5 and under

Priority for children of first responders and emergency service workers.

School districts throughout Suffolk County have been collaborating with the Child Care Council of Suffolk (CCCS) to assist families in finding appropriate child-care for children ages 5 and under.

There are currently 195 licensed and registered child-care programs open and available to serve children under age 5 in Suffolk County. County-wide there the number of spots available are:

383 slots for infants (up to 18 months)  
662 slots for toddlers (under 3 years)  
903 slots for preschoolers (3 and 4 years old)

In addition, the Stony Brook Child Care center is open for SBU Hospital employees, with capacity to serve up to 80 children under age 5. March 26, 2020

Any essential worker needing child-care will be referred to the CCCS hotline at 646-926-3784 to be connected with a referral specialist who will identify available programs that meet each parent's needs.

Información de cuidado infantil para niños menores de 5 años

Prioridad para los hijos de socorristas y trabajadores de servicios de emergencia.

Los distritos escolares de todo el condado de Suffolk han estado colaborando con el Consejo de Cuidado Infantil de Suffolk (CCCS) para ayudar a las familias a encontrar el cuidado adecuado de niños para niños de 5 años o menos.

Actualmente hay 195 programas de cuidado infantil con licencia y registrados abiertos y disponibles para servir a niños menores de 5 años en el condado de Suffolk. En todo el condado, el número de lugares disponibles son:

383 ranuras para bebés (hasta 18 meses)

662 ranuras para niños pequeños (menores de 3 años)

903 ranuras para niños en edad preescolar (3 y 4 años de edad)

Además, el centro de cuidado infantil Stony Brook está abierto para los empleados del Hospital SBU, con capacidad para atender hasta 80 niños menores de 5 años. 26 de marzo de 2020

Cualquier trabajador esencial que necesite cuidado infantil será referido a la línea directa de CCCS al 646-926-3784 para estar conectado con un especialista en referidos que identificará los programas disponibles que satisfagan las necesidades de cada padre.

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**SCOPE School District Emergency Extended Child Care Program**  
**in the Sachem School District**

At the request of your school district, SCOPE Education Services is pleased to provide emergency extended school age care during this difficult time. The program will be held Nokomis Elementary School located at 151 Holbrook Road, Holbrook, NY 11741.

Registration is limited to First Responders, Medical Personnel, Transit Workers and where space permits, other essential workers. Enrollment is on a first come, first serve basis and enrollment may be limited based on space and/or staffing.

The SCOPE Emergency Extended Child Care Program runs Monday through Friday from 7:00am - 6:30pm. Children must be school age Pre-K (must have turned 4 by 12/1/2019) – Grade 6.

To register for this Extended Day Program, current SCOPE families in the district need to:

1. Log into your Eleyo Account
2. Select Name of District and Extended Day Program
3. Scroll down to Season and select your District's Extended Day Program
4. Choose your Location Session
5. Follow the Instructions

**Create Your Account Profile** (New families to SCOPE)

1. Browse to the website: <https://scopeonline.ce.eleyo.com>
2. Create your profile by selecting Sign In (top, right corner).
3. To create a new profile, log in with Facebook or Google-or- select **Create One Now**.
4. When creating an account within the system, you will be required to enter your basic contact information including an email address (used for logging in) and a password. If your email address is recognized, use the *Send Forgot Password Email* to receive a password set email.  
 Note: If you are a First Responder or in the Medical Profession please indicate your job title and your place of work in the 'Place of Work' field.
5. Select *Manage All Relationships* to add family members and emergency contacts.

*An email will be sent from Eleyo with a link to verify your account. Use the Verify Your Email Address button on that email to verify your account.*

**Add Family Members and Emergency Contacts**

1. If you are not already on the website, browse to <https://scopeonline.ce.eleyo.com> and login with your email address and password by selecting the *Sign In* button.
2. Select your name in the top right, corner of the screen then select *Your Account/Relationships* to view your profile.
3. Use the **Add a Relationships** button to add all family members.
4. Select the **Create Person** button.
5. After you have finished setting up the people associated with your profile, select the SCOPE logo in the top, left area of the screen then select *Explore All Programs* then *Your Dashboard*.
6. On the left, under the *Manage Family Members* section, use the **Add Emergency Contacts** button to add new emergency contacts. Use the **Edit Emergency Contacts** button to update that information. In order to prevent creating duplicate users in the system, when adding an emergency contact that is already part of your profile, please search for the name then select from the list of existing users that are presented.

**Register for your School District's Extended Day Program**

1. To register, select *Before and Aftercare* on the welcome page, then select *Enroll Now*.
2. Walk through the registration and submit your child's contract. Follow the same steps to register additional children in the family.
3. Select Name of District and Extended Day Program
4. Scroll down to Season and select your District's Extended Day Program
5. Choose your Location /Session
6. Follow the instructions including payment information. **Please note that you WILL NOT be charged.** You will receive a confirmation email.

Programa de Cuidado Infantil Extendido por Emergencia del Distrito Escolar de SCOPE en el Distrito Escolar de Sachem

A petición de su distrito escolar, SCOPE Education Services se complace en proporcionar atención de edad escolar extendida de emergencia durante este momento difícil. El programa se llevará a cabo en la Escuela Primaria Nokomis ubicada en 151 Holbrook Road, Holbrook, NY 11741.

El registro se limita a los Primeros Respondedores, Personal Médico, Trabajadores de Tránsito y donde el espacio lo permita, otros trabajadores esenciales. La inscripción es por orden de llegada, el primer servicio y la inscripción puede ser limitada en función del espacio y/o el personal.

El Programa de Cuidado Infantil Extendido de Emergencia SCOPE funciona de lunes a viernes de 7:00am a 6:30pm. Los niños deben ser en edad escolar Pre-K (debe haber cambiado 4 antes del 12/1/2019) – Grado 6.

Para inscribirse en este Programa de Día Extendido, las familias actuales de SCOPE en el distrito necesitan:

1. Inicie sesión en su cuenta de Eleyo
2. Seleccione el Nombre del Distrito y el Programa de Día Extendido
3. Desplácese hacia abajo hasta Temporada y seleccione el Programa de Día Extendido de su Distrito
4. Elija su sesión de ubicación
5. Siga las instrucciones

#### Crear su perfil de cuenta (nuevas familias en SCOPE)

1. Vaya al sitio web: <https://scopeonline.ce.eleyo.com>
2. Crea tu perfil seleccionando Iniciar sesión (esquina superior derecha).
3. Para crear un nuevo perfil, inicia sesión con Facebook o Google o- selecciona Crear uno ahora.

4. Al crear una cuenta dentro del sistema, se le pedirá que introduzca su información de contacto básica, incluida una dirección de correo electrónico (utilizada para iniciar sesión) y una contraseña.
