All-National Musician

Sachem High School North student Carly Salzano has been selected as a member of the 2022 National Association for Music Education All-National Honor Band. Carly, who plays the trumpet, was selected for this prestigious honor after a rigorous application and audition process. She first competed at the local, district and state level to become eligible.

The 2022 All-National Honor Ensembles will perform this November in National Harbor, Maryland. Carly will join the nation's top high school musicians to showcase their talents during a concert that celebrates music education and the arts.

Sachem spirit was on display across the district ahead of homecoming on Oct. 8. Leading up to the big games at Sachem High School East and North, both schools celebrated with a spirit week that culminated with pep rally.



In addition, Sachem High School North held its first homecoming tour, where the football teams, cheerleaders and Arrowettes traveled to some of the district's elementary schools to get students excited about the weekend.

Thirty current students earned the designation of Advanced Placement Scholars with Distinction for excelling on their 2022 AP exams. The AP Scholar with Distinction status is granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.



During National School Bus Safety Week, the district welcomed BusPatrol to Hiawatha Elementary School to launch its “Thumbs Up” campaign. BusPatrol, the leading stop-arm enforcement technology provider, rolled out the campaign to educate students on the rules of the road surrounding bus safety.

Throughout October, the district supported Breast Cancer Awareness Month through several activities. Students and staff educated themselves and their school communities about the impact of breast cancer and how to promote

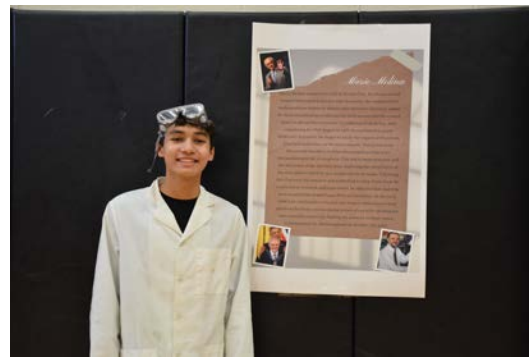
awareness.

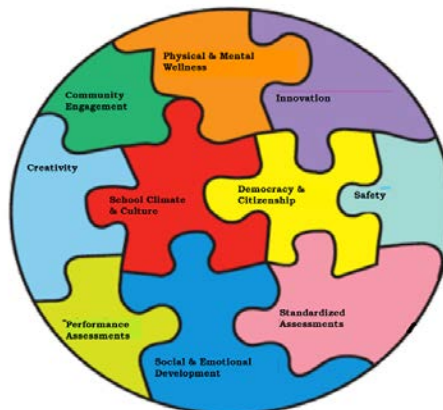
