High School East Student Awarded Prestigious Scholarship

Sachem High School East senior Arianna Ciregna has been awarded the Rensselaer Medal. The Rensselaer Medal is a prestigious scholarship opportunity awarded to secondary school students who have distinguished themselves in mathematics and science. If Arianna is accepted to and chooses to attend Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, she will be awarded \$30,000 per year in scholarship money for four years.

The Sachem Marching Band took home the title of New York State champions in the Large School 3 Division at the New York State Field Band Conference. The band, made up of 62 students from Sachem High School East, Sachem High School North, Sagamore Middle School, Samoset Middle School and Seneca Middle School, traveled to Syracuse, New York, to compete in the championship on Oct. 30.

Former professional basketball player, Chris Herren, visited High School East to share a powerful message about substance use prevention. He empowered students to rethink how they look at addiction and through sharing his own experiences, touched on topics such as drinking and drug use, peer pressure and bullying.



At High School North, students taking essential kitchen skills learned the "farm to table" concept through harvesting their own food from the school garden. They made their own fries using sweet potatoes they grew. Students cured and cut the produce into fry form while practicing safe knife skills. Ultimately, they made a delicious snack and were involved throughout the entire process.

Students at Waverly Elementary School planted peace promises around the building's grounds. Students at each grade level received daffodil bulbs with a paper peace promise attached. They wrote pledges of things they would do to make for a positive school year. For example, some students pledged to give other compliments, be kind, use positive words and pick up garbage.





In collaboration with the Farmingville Fire Department, Tamarac Elementary School's PTA organized a candy drive. Students brought in unopened, excess Halloween candy to be sent to troops overseas. Additionally, some students created cards for military members, thanking them for serving the country.

From participating in parades, to Turkey Trots and Thanksgiving feasts, our students were excited to celebrate the holiday! In addition to the fun activities, local businesses teamed up with both high schools to make Thanksgiving a little brighter for some Sachem families. Students assisted in collecting turkeys and putting together donation baskets ensuring families had a complete Thanksgiving meal.

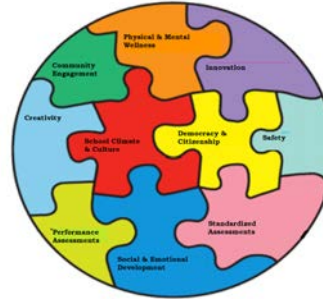
