Non-Medicaid Service Coordination

Non Medicaid Service Coordination is a short-term service funded by a grant from the Family Support Services (FSS) Division of the Long Island Developmental Disabilities Regional Office (LIDDRO), Office of People with a Developmental Disability (OPWDD).

Our grant representative can assist parents in obtaining OPWDD eligibility for their children under the age of 18 years if they have significant on-going need(s) that can be addressed by the OPWDD Medicaid Waiver Services.

Once eligibility and needs are established and approved our representative can guide the process to meet the state requirements for Medicaid Service Coordination (MSC). Once an MSC is selected, a local provider for the needed waiver service has to be identified. If the waiver service(s) is approved by the local LIDDRO, then our representative can assist in obtaining Medicaid for the requested service. (Note: we can also assist qualified adults with a developmental disability.)

If there is no need at this time for on-going comprehensive services, our representatives can refer you to other non-Medicaid services under the Family Support Services.
