# Advisory Name Game



**Step 1:** Position the advisory class in a circle with desks (or go outside)

**Step 2:** Give High-Five Greeting sequencing around the circle, students greet each other with a high-five (including Advisor)

*For example, Kim says, “Hi, Ahmed,” and gives him a high-five. He replies, “Hi, Kim,” and gives her a high-five.*

**Step 3:** Sequentially, each student will share (describe) the origins of their name and why it was chosen for them; circle will respond to each individual student with “Hi, + name of the student (who just spoke)”

**\*Bonus Step 4:** Have each member of the Advisory circle share out a response to what has influenced who they are: *family traditions and characteristics* (e.g., family members, favorite activities, holidays, customs, religion, foods you eat, native languages, attitudes toward education, family rules)

# *Review of 1st Trimester Progress Reports Reminders (strategies for success)*



1. Progress reports are a great way to assess what is working (and what may not be) and to re-set goals for the trimester
2. Progress reports *are not included* in your academic history on the high school transcript.
3. When reviewing grades in the AERIES portal (under “grades”), make note of any *surprises* and connect with teachers to discuss how to improve.
4. Utilize available resources (teacher office hours, [tutoring by department \(link here\)](#), NHS tutors, PALs and connect with classmates.
