## *Logging into Kelvin Pulse Check*

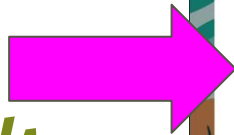


