- Dr. Valenzuela attended the Arizona I-19 Most Influential Person, and one of our friends Angie King was recognized, for her support and sponsorship of the NJROTC Program. Congratulations to Mrs. King.
- Dr. Valenzuela shared that Ben Lebovitz was selected as one of the top ten finalist for Teacher of the Year.
