

Welcome to February! February (do you see that extra "r"?) is one of the most frequently misspelled words in the English language. In 2015, even the White House press office got it wrong several times over the course of the month. The Healthy Relationship Education Staff of Arizona Youth Partnership will be presenting Positive Potential to the 6th and 7th graders during the week of February 3rd-7th. Positive Potential is developed by PATH, Inc. and has been presented in schools and communities nationally as well as locally. The program encompasses a wide variety of relevant subjects such as bullying, responsible social media use, self-confidence, and risky behavior, all pertinent to the needs of students as they grow and mature. 6th graders just submitted their first argumentive essay in ELA and Social Studies.

In science, they will have a project on Earth's Tilt and a lab on Absorption and Radiation by Land and Water. 7th graders will also have a lab in science on weather patterns and a project on weather forecasting. 8th graders will have an informative essay in ELA, a short writing on economics in social studies, and a science lab on natural selection. February will also be the start of our small group interventions. The purpose of this is to provide supplemental support to students who tested below grade level on their December I-Ready Reading diagnostic, ensuring they are receiving targeted interventions on grade level standards where needed. Students who did not take or complete the reading diagnostic in December will automatically be pulled for this small group instruction. This serves as a good reminder that I-Ready diagnostic testing and state testing should be given the utmost effort and completed fully. These assessments provide extremely important data that we use as a school to make informed decisions for each students' educational goals. Once students demonstrate mastery of grade level standards, they will no longer need to attend small group instruction.

Civics Test:


The final Civics Test, a graduation requirement, will be administered on February 12th at 9:30 AM in the Hawks Nest.

Attendance Reminders

Sahuarita Digital Pathways Academy is officially its own school this year! As an approved online school, we have mandatory attendance guidelines that we have to follow in order to operate. We are required to report daily attendance minutes for our SDPA students. A strong home-school partnership is needed in order to complete this required task. We need your help each school day to meet this guideline.

All SDPA students will need a Daily Attendance Log completed by a parent or guardian EACH school day.

Sahuarita Digital Pathways Academy AOI Daily Attendance Log: K -12

Each school day, you will submit the Google Form to report the total number of minutes that your child engaged in their school-related activities including:

- Time spent in live Google Meets (including lessons, Homeroom, Academic Enrichment, and Elective Enrichment).
- Time spent working on asynchronous activities in Google Classroom, Seesaw, i-Ready, Edgenuity, or another online platform.
- Time spent working 1-on-1 with a teacher or learning coach.
- Time spent working on projects, independent reading, writing, or completing offline assignments.
- Time spent working on special activities like Library, Music, PE, Computer Lab, Counseling, etc.

A separate Google Form needs to be completed for each child. Per board policy, students with 10 consecutive absences will be withdrawn. Forms are due each school day by midnight. Thank you so much for your partnership in this process!
