Call to the Public: Mr. Noah Sundberg

Mr. Sundberg spoke to address the Dress Code Policy. He is glad that we are adding more colors. He feels that the Dress Code is overly restrictive and unnecessary. He feels that teachers are spending too much time focusing on attire rather than education. He feels that it is a distraction from the educational process to worry about uniforms. He feels that is burdensome on budgets because it means that you buy more clothes. Mr. Sundberg correlates the dress code policy with District Letter Grades. He has dealt with the uniform code and feels that it is not followed. He hopes that when the Dress Code Policy is discussed that a more reasonable policy is considered.
