Business Days in the Texas Public Information Act

House Bill 3033 (HB 3033), effective September 1, 2023, adds new Texas Government Code section 552.0031, which defines *business day* for purposes of the Texas Public Information Act (PIA).

The law provides that a business day means a day other than:

- A Saturday or Sunday.
- A national holiday: New Year's Day; Martin Luther King, Jr., Day; Presidents Day; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Veterans Day; Thanksgiving Day; and Christmas Day.
- A state holiday: Confederate Heroes Day; Texas Independence Day; San Jacinto Day; Emancipation Day; Lyndon Baines Johnson Day; the Friday after Thanksgiving Day; the 24th day of December; and the 26th day of December.
- Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, and Good Friday, if observed by the public information officer of the school district.
- The Friday or Monday before or after a national or state holiday listed above, if the holiday falls on the weekend and the district observes the holiday on that Friday or Monday.

Tex. Gov't Code § 552.0031.

A school district may designate a day on which the district's administrative offices are closed or operating with minimum staffing (skeleton crew) as a *non-business day*. As amended by HB 3033, the PIA now allows governmental bodies to designate up to 10 non-business days during a calendar year. For a school district, the designation of nonbusiness days must be made by the board of trustees. Tex. Gov't Code § 552.0031(f).
