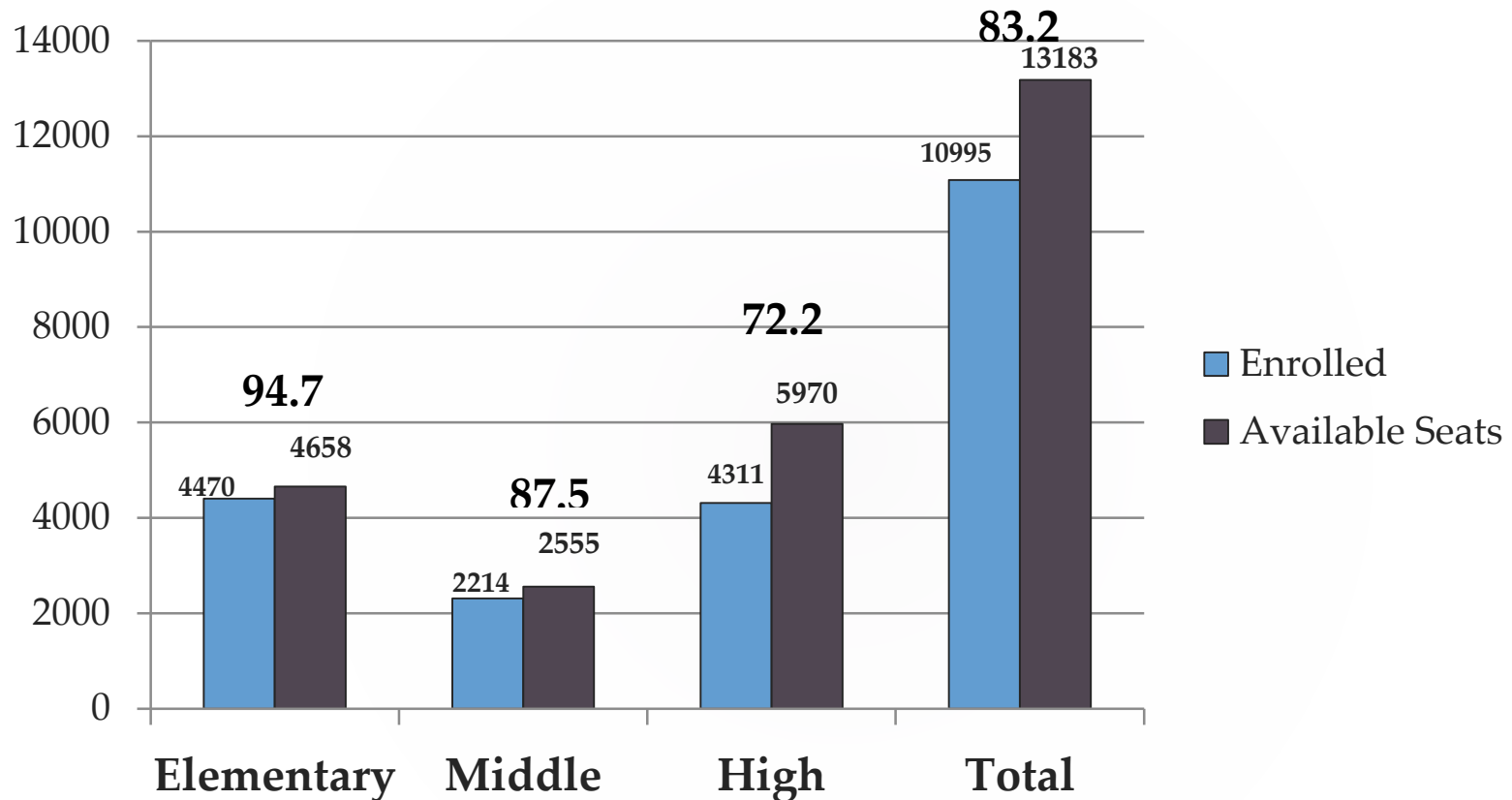

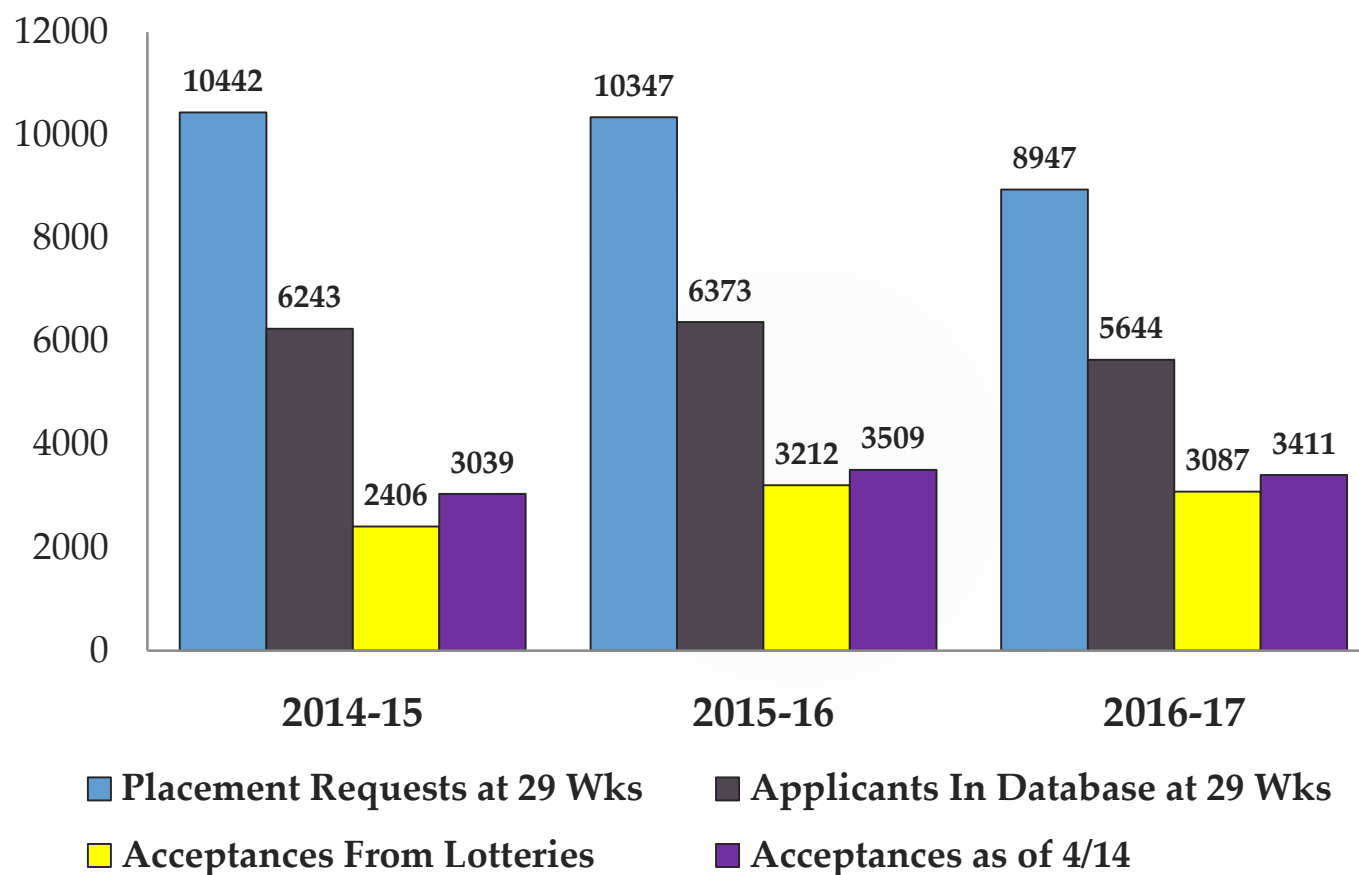

# Comparison: Similar Point In Time

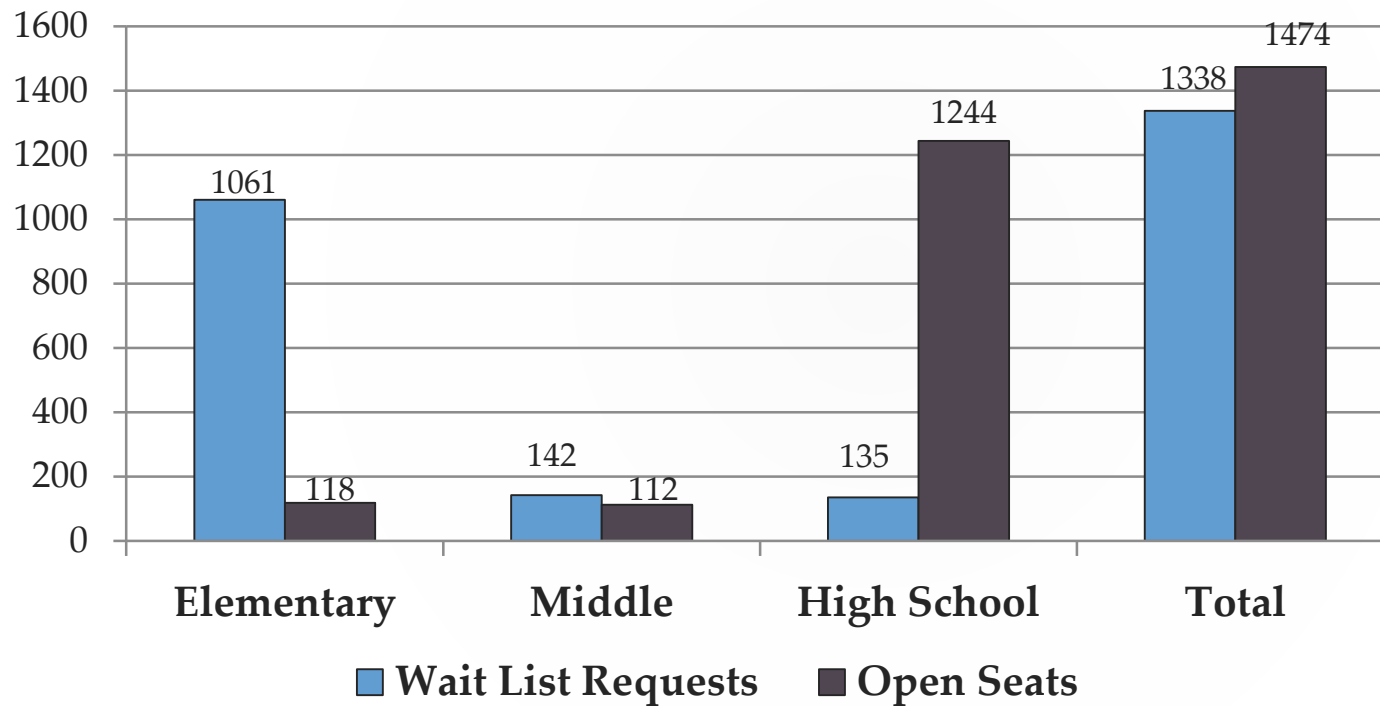


# **Online Application and 2 Pool Lottery System:**

## **4<sup>th</sup> Year Using Online System - 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Using 2 Pools**

- Online (5082) vs paper (3869) application submission shows 56.8% submitting online
- Online submission %age has increased 4.5% over last year
- System revisions give parents more dashboard information on application status
- Email communications continue as primary method to inform of eligibility status and placement updates
- 2 Pool system proving less confusing for families applying for a school and then for another if not accepted in first lottery

## Next Steps

- Continue to assist high schools with applicant eligibility determinations and placements
- Update schools/grades with openings website postings and placement
- Send acceptance and non-placement notices to applicants as needed
- Proceed with plans for recruitment events and literature preparing for 2016-17 school year recruiting and application period
- Implement Gifted Programs application and placement process separate from General Education Magnet and Choice Schools
- Implement recommendations from process assessment consultants
- Implement marketing surveys into information, application and communications processes
