Activity Idea

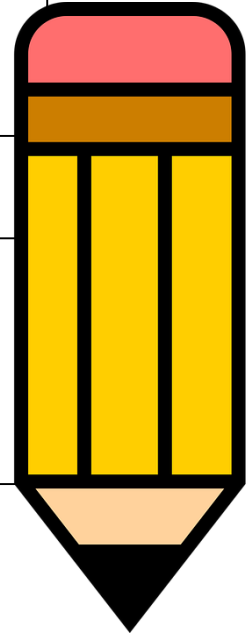
Make an all about me bag! Help your child put 4-6 items in a brown lunch bag. Decorate the bag. The items and the decorations should represent your child in some way. For example, if they love soccer, include a soccer keychain. Talk about the bag’s contents together, or have them share it with a friend or family member.

Language at Home

Learning “All About Me” provides many great opportunities for language. Consider talking about your child’s emotions, senses, and interests. Work together to learn about each other, finding out what your child loves the most.

This theme also provides a great context for learning about others! Encourage your child to think about others. Do all children think the same way or have the same interests? How is your child similar or different than his/her classmates?

For older children, take some time to talk through new words they will hear during virtual learning like internet, browser, app, install, upload, etc.
