Why the increase in applicants?

- ▶ Media: Radio and TV ads
- ▶ Print: Post card mailing 3 weeks prior to lottery applications deadline
- ▶ Internet: “Survey” application was introduced prior to winter break
- ▶ Schools more actively recruiting
- ▶ Two additional recruitment fair events held
 - 1 Weeknight in County (Magic House)
 - 1 Weekend day in City (Compton/Drew)
