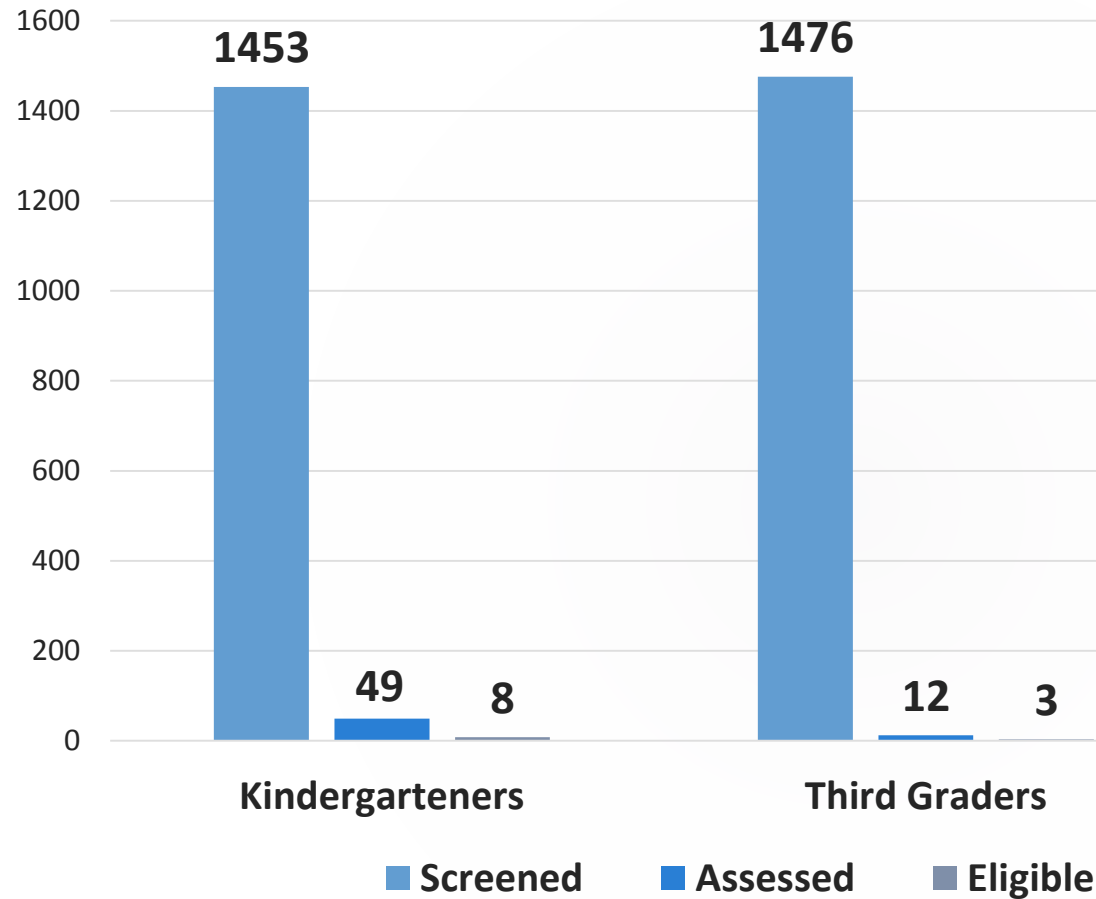

2016-2017 SCREENING and ASSESSMENT PLAN



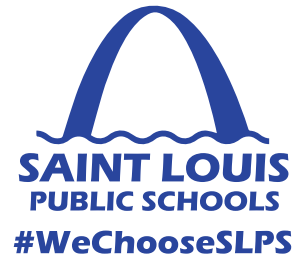
- ❑ Used CogAT screener to identify students for further assessment (**2,929**)
- ❑ Classroom teachers administered paper and pencil screener to all KG and 3rd graders in October
- ❑ Students who scored at or above the 85th percentile were given intelligence and academic achievement assessments in Nov. – Feb. (**61**)
- ❑ Received data six weeks after administration

2016-2017 UNIVERSAL SCREENING - YEAR 1



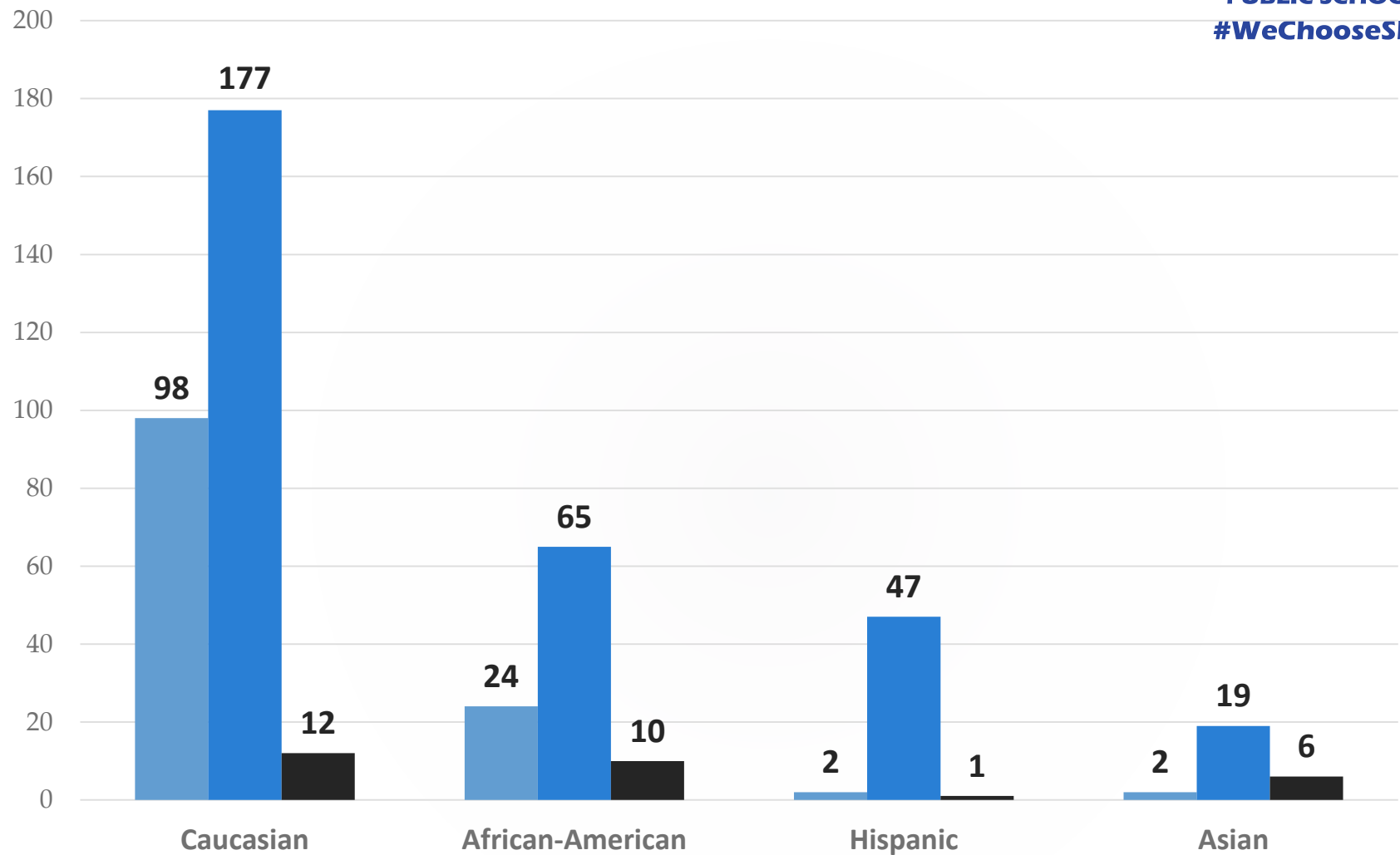

2017-2018 UNIVERSAL SCREENING – YEAR 2



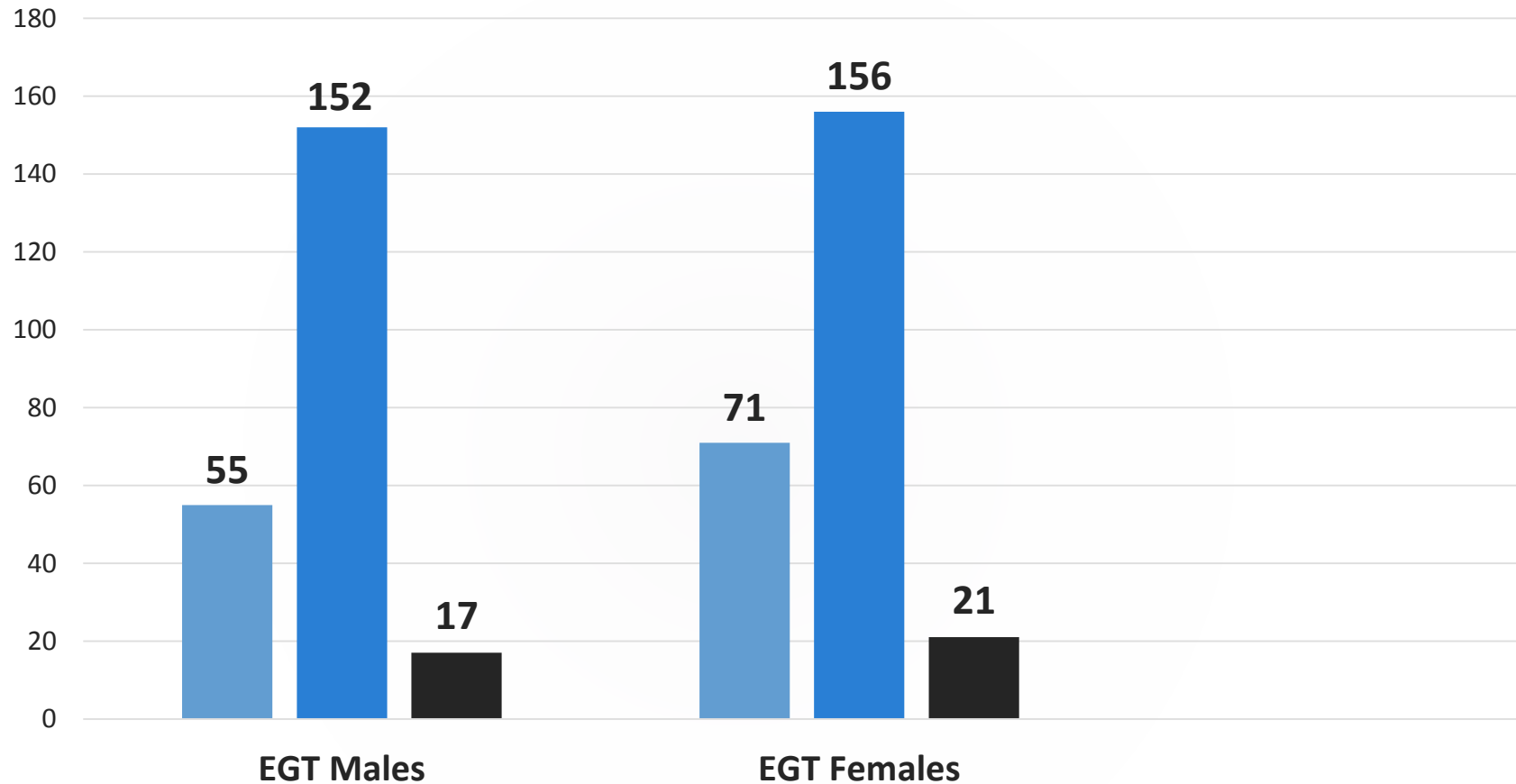
- ❑ Gifted teachers will be trained in January on administering the screening assessment
- ❑ Gifted teachers will administer the on-line screening assessments using I-Pads to all Second and Third graders in February
- ❑ Students who scored at or above the 85th percentile will be given the intelligence and academic achievement assessments in March-April
- ❑ Data will be reported within 3-5 business days

ELIGIBILITY BY RACE

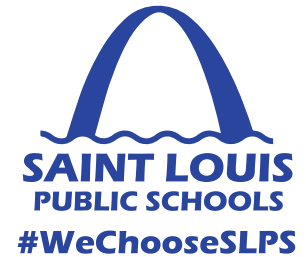
