





POSITIVE

- District earned 70% of the points two consecutive years
- 12 points were earned in Mathematics – both progress & growth
- All 8 points were earned in Social Studies (status & progress)
- CCR points related to ACT/SAT/ASVAB/Compass is higher than 2 years ago – but lower than last year – 6 points were earned the last 2 years
- CCR points related to Dual Enrolled/Dual Credit/IRC deemed 8 points – strong showing in this standard
- CCR points related to 180 Day follow-up increased to 10 points over last year. Positive placement is evident—increasing from 75.4% two years ago to over 85% for 2016.
- Participation rate in Junior ACT assessments increased by 2.1% and the average composite score by 1%

NEGATIVE

- 6 points rather than 12 points were earned in ELA – Hold Harmless was enacted
- 0 points in Science were earned
- While points were earned, District is concerned about the replacement for COMPASS as an entry exam for community college

POSITIVE

- For the 3rd year in a row, the District earned all 10 points in attendance, raising the overall rate to 88.3% of the students attending 90% of the time.
- For the 2nd year in a row, the District earned all 30 of the graduation points. The six-year graduation rate raised from 69.2% to 77.1% in three years.

NEGATIVE

- While earning all graduation points, District needs to address the 4 and 5 year graduation rates
