FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

✎ **Grab and Go Breakfast Program (25) – *Do not eat in classroom***

- ❑ High Schools (13)
- ❑ Middle Schools (9)
- ❑ Elementary Schools (2)
- ❑ Alternative Program(1)

✎ **Traditional Cafeteria Program : (71)**

- ❑ All schools

✎ **Breakfast In the Classroom: (1) Prek**

- ❑ Patrick Henry Elementary School

PROPOSED

FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

Grab ‘n Go Breakfast in Classroom

- ❑ Students pick up breakfast from kiosks and bring it to the classroom

Breakfast in the Classroom – All Elementary Schools PreK

- ❑ Students eat at their desks during the first 20 minutes of the school day

Second Chance Breakfast

- ❑ Students get breakfast from a designated location during an extended break after first period.

NEXT STEPS



- ❑ **Average Daily Participation (ADP) submitted to Grant Consultant (Partners for the BIC Grant) to determine eligibility**
- ❑ **Pre-select participating schools (based on eligibility)**
- ❑ **Eligibility status known before Friday, October 20, 2017**
- ❑ **Start writing PROPOSAL**
 - ❑ *{inclusive of grant team – Operation Food Search, the District’s Food and Nutrition Services Department, Southwest Food Service Excellence and the Office of Institutional Advancement.}*

PROPOSED TIMELINE

- ❑ **Submit Proposal (due date not yet determined)**
- ❑ **District receives notification status 2 weeks after submission of Grant.**
- ❑ **Submit board resolution to the SAB for approval.**
- ❑ **Roll-out Implementation Plan (i.e., meeting with Network Superintendents and Principals of approved selected schools)**
