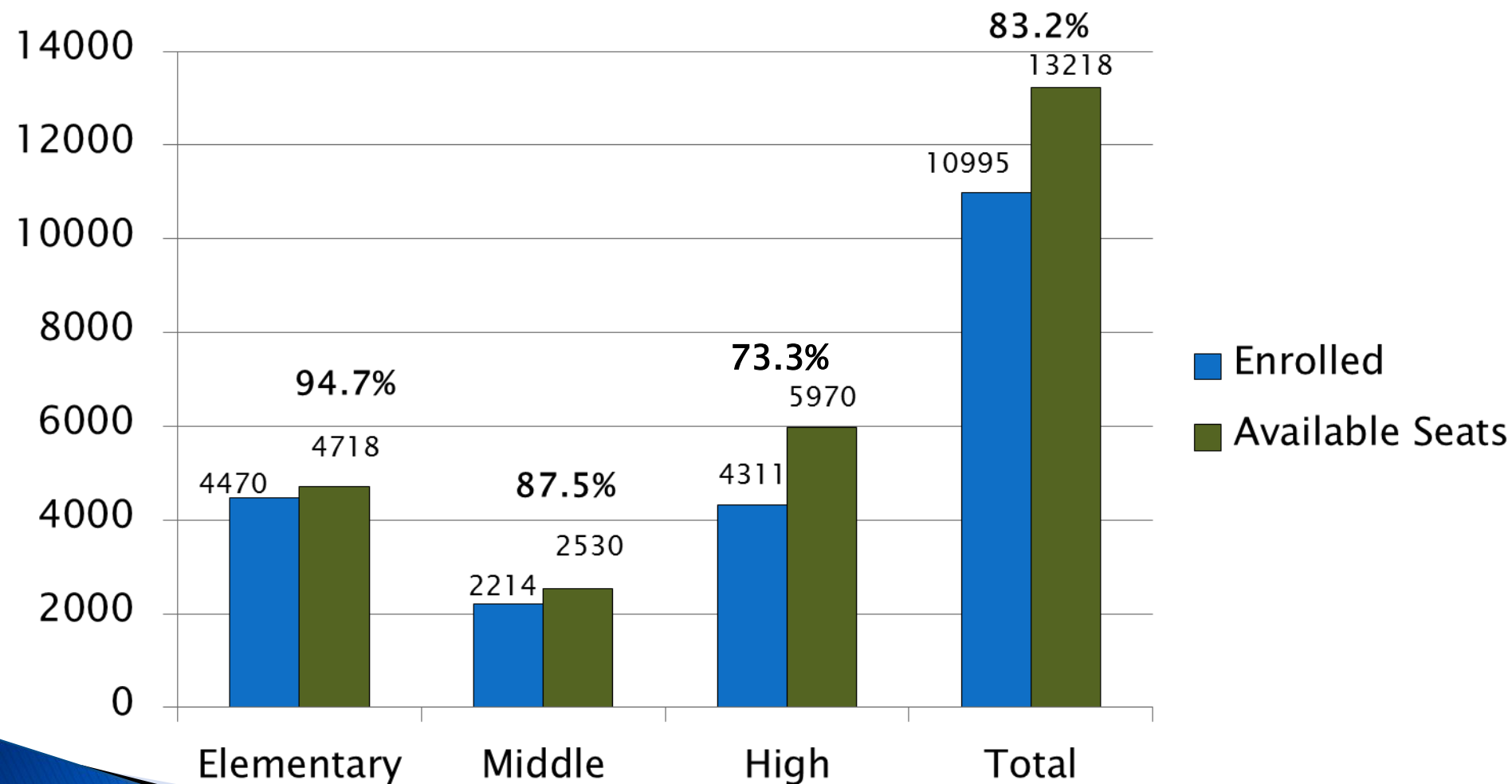

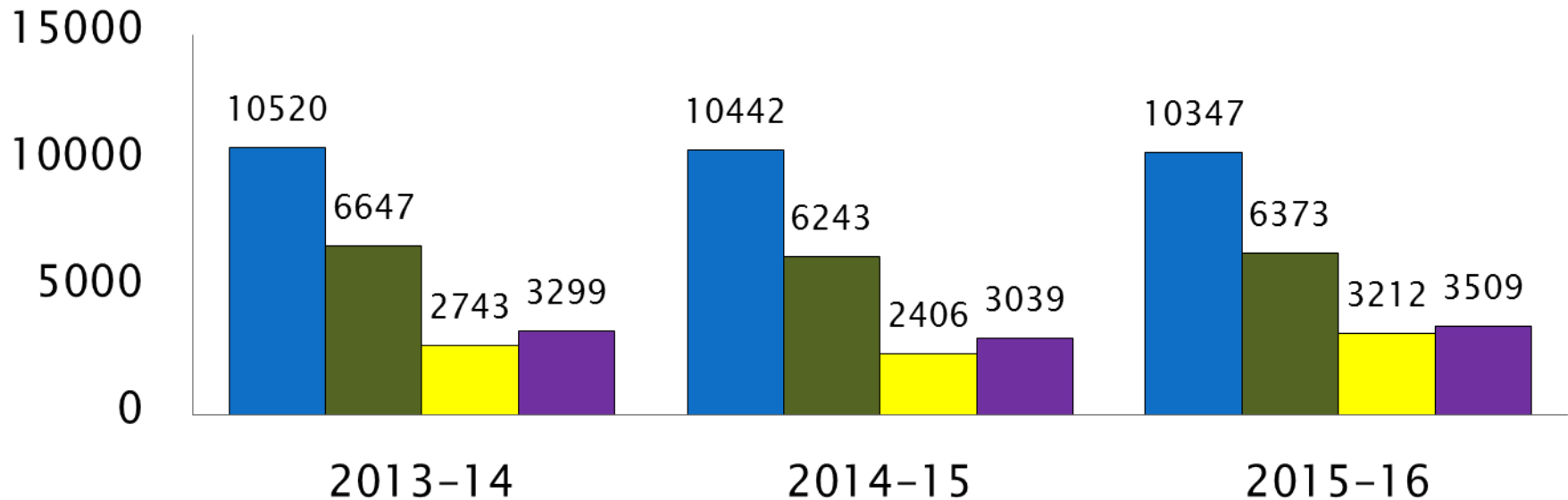

Comparison: Similar Point In Time



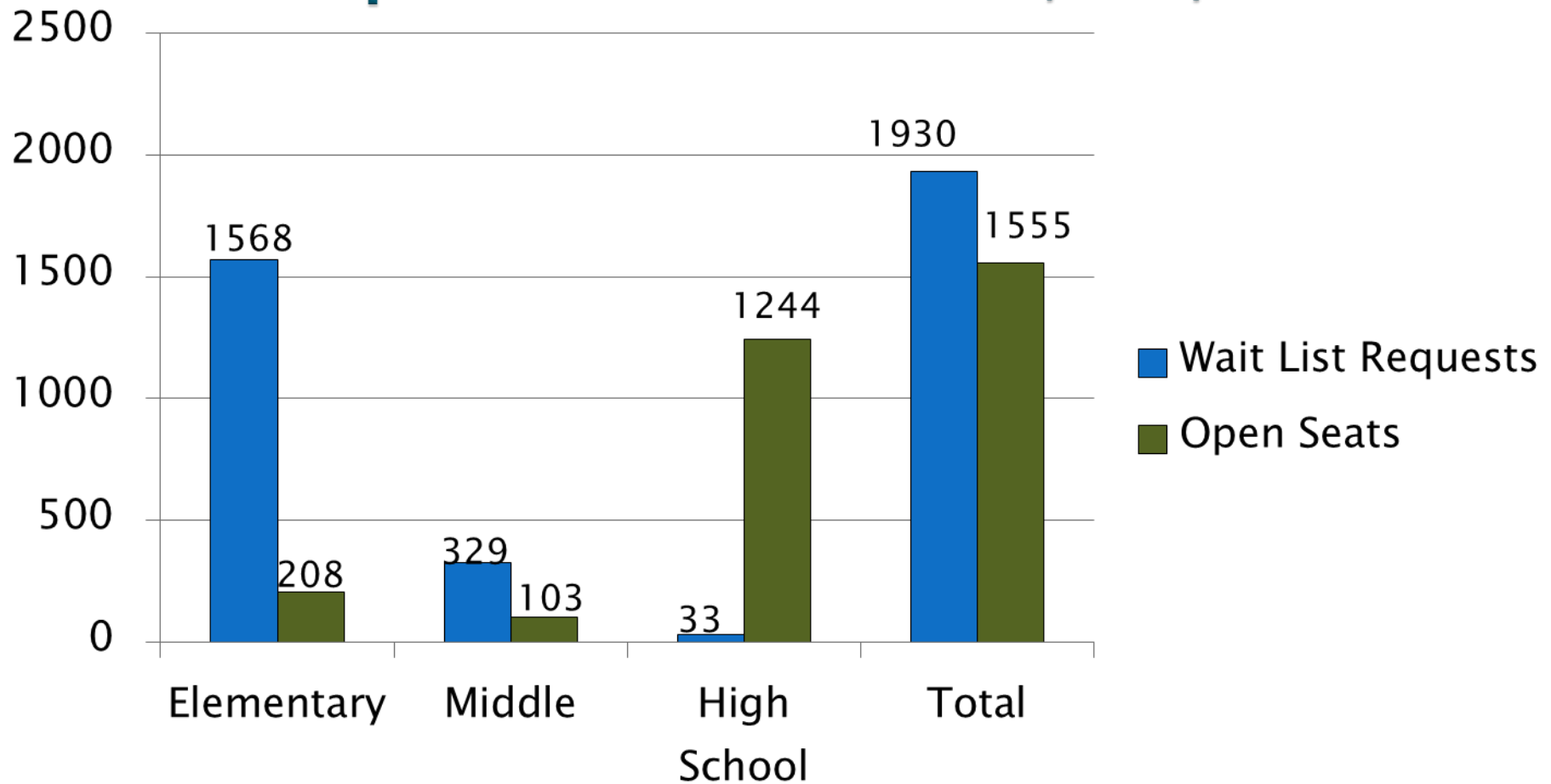
- Placement Requests at 29 Wks
- Applicants In Database at 29 Wks
- Acceptances From Lotteries
- Acceptances as of 4/20



Online Application and Two Pool Lottery System: Third Year Using Online System First Year Using Two Pools

- ▶ Online application system allows for faster data entry and better response time
- ▶ Parents have ability to view application status online
- ▶ Email communications provide instant eligibility status and placement updates
- ▶ Updated Two Pool application and lottery process allowed high schools to determine eligibility status using 1st quarter 8th grade achievement
- ▶ Two Pool system proving less confusing for families applying for a school and then for another if not accepted

Wait Lists Requests for 2015–2016 and Open Seats as of 4/20/2015



Next Steps

- ▶ Continue to assist high schools with applicant eligibility determinations and placements
- ▶ Update schools/grades with openings website postings
- ▶ Send acceptance and non-placement notices to applicants as needed
- ▶ “Turn Off” ability to apply to schools projected as full with lengthy wait list encouraging submission to open sites
- ▶ Continue development of interface with SIS
- ▶ Proceed with plans for recruitment events and literature preparing for 2016-17 school year recruiting and application period
