- Group was unanimously approved by the Charter Advisory Committee
- Will have a Performance Improvement Plan through the Office Of Innovation and New Schools



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Lighthouse Academies Charter will employ a model based on the following essentials:

- Standards Driven Rigorous Research Based Programs
- Social Curriculum and SHINE
- Data Driven Instruction
- Professional Development
- More Time on Instruction – Extended day and year

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Lighthouse Academies Charter

- Occupy the SLPS Mitchell School Building
- Start with K – 5 Fall 2012, grow to K–12 as capacity grows.
- A strong board (composed of local stakeholders) will work with the established management group Lighthouse Charters.
- Group was unanimously approved by the Charter Advisory Committee.
- Performance Improvement Plan developed and monitored through the Office of Innovation and New Schools
