# CONTEXT



## Summer learning supports several key areas:

- Preventing summer learning loss
- Increasing opportunities for intervention and credit recovery, including students who qualify for summer learning through SB319
- Decreasing summer “opportunity gap” by providing enrichment through the arts, chess, project-based learning and college preparatory coursework

# 2018 SUMMER OUTCOMES



- ❑ Every 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade student attending Summer Learning took the STAR assessment on June 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> to measure progress.

| Growth                             | Number of Students | % of Students |

| <b>Less than 1 month of growth</b> | <b>351</b>         | <b>50%</b>    |
| <b>1 month of growth</b>           | <b>58</b>          | <b>8%</b>     |

| <b>3 months of growth</b>          | <b>46</b>          | <b>7%</b>     |
| <b>4 to 6 months of growth</b>     | <b>102</b>         | <b>15%</b>    |
| <b>7 or more months of growth</b>  | <b>105</b>         | <b>15%</b>    |



|---|-----------------------------|---------------------------|
| Less than 1 month of growth                                     | 50%                         | 35%                       |
| 1 month of growth   | 14%                         | 10%                       |
| 2 months of growth  | 5%                          | 15%                       |
| 3 months of growth  | 7%                          | 10%                       |
| 4 to 6 months of growth   | 15%                         | 15%                       |
| 7 or more months of growth                                      | 15%                         | 15%                       |

# 2019 SUMMER LEARNING PROGRAMS



| PROGRAMS  | WHO ATTENDS?  |
|---|---|
| Literacy Academy  | SB 319 students, retained students (1-8), students 1+ years behind in reading (P4s-8)                                     |
| Extended School Year  | Students with IEPs who are eligible for an extension of special education services, including ECSE                        |
| High School Credit Recovery                                 | High school students who need to earn course credit and/or who need academic intervention support for End of Course exams |
| Gifted and Enrichment                                       | Gifted students and students who are on grade level (P4s-8th)   |
| College Prep Academy and ACT Prep Programs                  | Students who plan to take AP course in the fall for elective credit, HS enrichment students                               |
| 8 <sup>th</sup> to 9 <sup>th</sup> Grade Transition Program | Students transitioning from 8 <sup>th</sup> to 9 <sup>th</sup> grade.   |
| ELL Programs  | Newcomers (K-8), ELL (K-8) students from ELL center schools   |

| Student Enrollment | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> School based committee responsible for recruiting students and communicating with families</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Increased efficiency in registering through online registration</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Focus on increasing enrollment in College Readiness Pre-AP and ACT Prep program</li></ul>   |
