







SLPS Magnet and Choice Schools Enrollment Status as of 1/31/14




Comparison: Similar points in Time



Online Application and 3 Pool System: Year 2

- ▶ Online application system allows for faster data entry and better response time
- ▶ Parents have ability to view application status online
- ▶ Letter generator component saves time/effort and has allowed for quicker communications
- ▶ Interface with District SIS system being developed
- ▶ High Schools using the system to identify and track applicants has been challenging
- ▶ 3 Pool application and lottery process identifies earlier the schools/grades with openings or short wait lists
- ▶ Early info helps to inform parents and target them to apply for these specific schools

Next Steps

- ▶ Assist high schools with applicant eligibility determinations and placements
- ▶ Advertising of schools/grades with openings
 - Currently on SLPS and Magnet/Choice website
 - Radio/print ads running 3 weeks to Feb. 14.
- ▶ Pool C lottery on Feb. 7, 2014
- ▶ 3rd round of acceptance notifications out Feb. 14, 2014
- ▶ Non-placement notices sent Feb. 14, 2014
- ▶ ***Propose*** later start date for 2015-16 application period:
Oct. 1 vs. Sept. 1 and implement 2 pool system.

Shenandoah Community Efforts
