# Promotion and Retention Policies

## Missouri Statute for Transitional School District

- Requires students in grades 1–8 to have universal screening for reading
- Requires ALL students who do not achieve grade level standards in reading to attend summer school
- Requires students not be promoted to a higher grade level unless reading at or above grade level

# Promotion and Retention Policies

## Senate Bill 319

- Requires reading assessment within 45 days of the end of calendar year
- Requires the development of a reading plan with a minimum of 30 hours of reading outside the regular school day for students reading one or more years below grade level
- Mandates summer school for 4<sup>th</sup> grade and recommends for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade with 40 hours of reading instruction
- Mandates retention for 4<sup>th</sup> grade IF a student has not been previously retained
- States retention ceases after 4<sup>th</sup> grade for a low reading level and noted on the student's file

# Beyond Regular Instructional Day.....


Within the regular school year, students received:

- Intervention as determined by the Individual Academic Plan
  - ▣ Academic Instructional Coach flexible groups
  - ▣ Class-size reduction teacher
  - ▣ Volunteer experts
  - ▣ Small group instruction
- Tutoring within the school day

Prior to summer school, schools submitted:

- ▣ A Status Report of students who were required to attend summer school.

# Summer School Instructional Monitoring

- ▶ Weekly monitoring report of skills to improve reading
  - ▶ Instructional Plan of 40 hours of reading intervention
  - ▶ IAPs and STAR data guide instruction
  - ▶ Progress report indicates the types of intervention and the number of hours of reading instruction
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# Notables.....

- ▶ **The (TFA) Summer Institute** is in Jefferson, Carr Lane and Sumner High.
  - ▶ **Pupil Accounting:** Of 9124 students flagged in SIS with an intent to attend summer school, 7167 students through K-12 have enrolled along with including 34 Pre-K.
  - ▶ **Academic Fairs:** All K-8 sites will conduct an Academic Fair during the last week to share their Project-based Learning.
  - ▶ **Perfect Attendance:** Approximately 2100 students will participate in perfect attendance trips on July 1.
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
