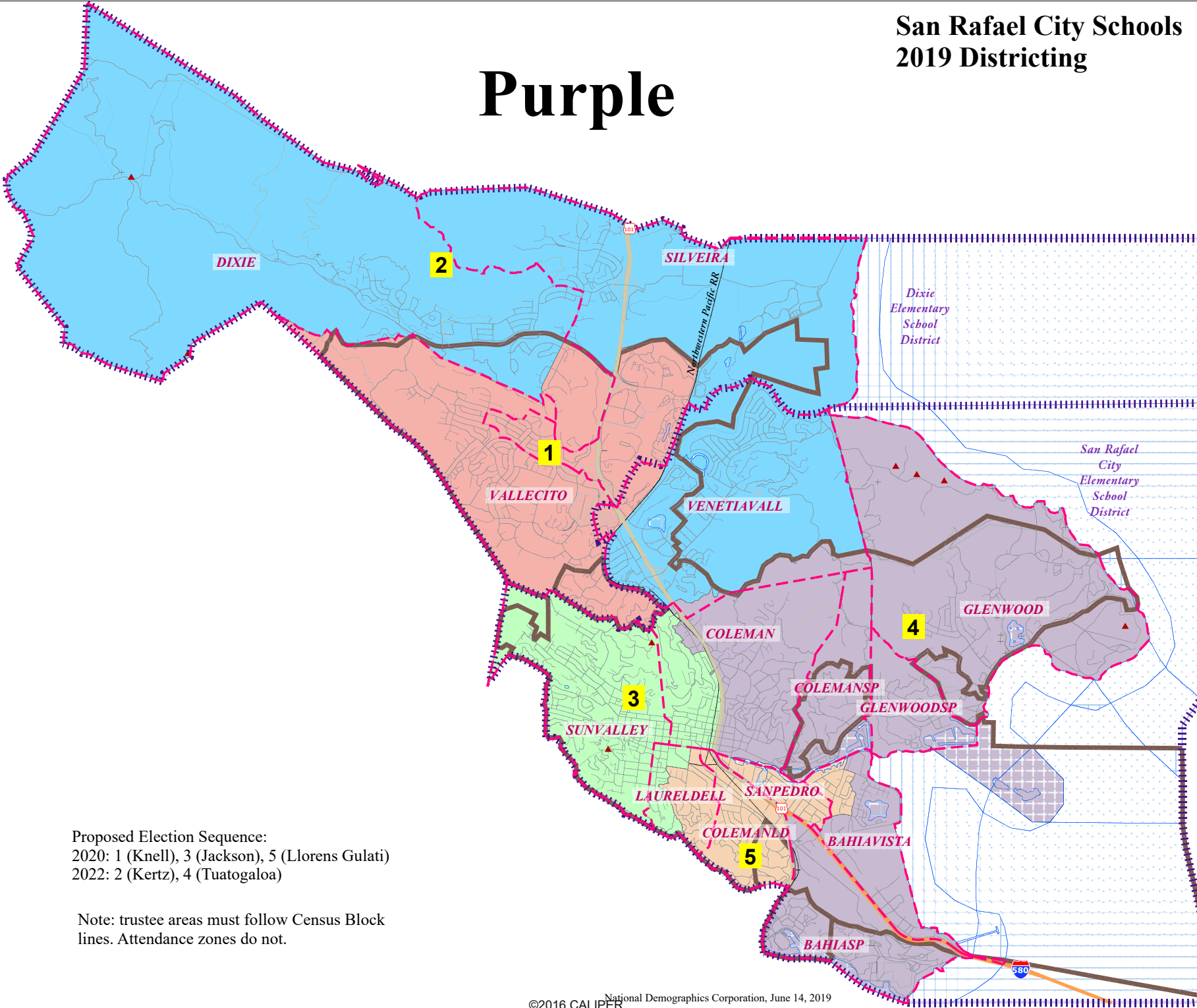

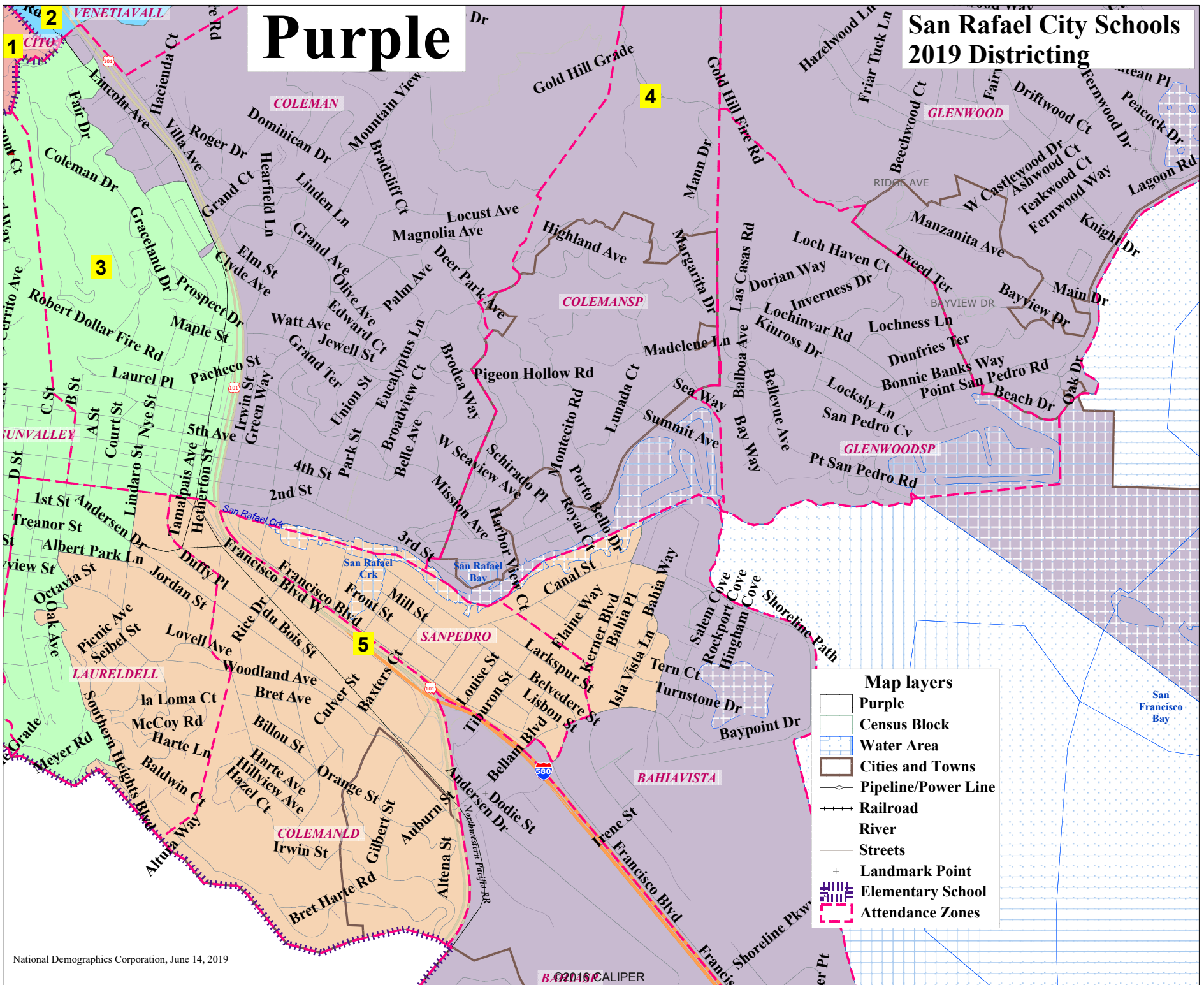


Proposed Election Sequence:
