




# Considerations for Identifying Values:

#### Four Shifts to Consider:


- Design and Innovation

#### I am a Creative Problem Solver who:


Categories	Beginner	Advanced
Identifies Problems	I work to understand the problem.  I define the significance of the problem.	I understand how the problem relates to other problems.  I evaluate the significance and complexity of the problem.
Considers Multiple Approaches	I collect information from a variety of sources.	I use resources inside and outside the classroom, library and internet to better understand the problem.
	I research multiple possible approaches.	I use multiple approaches to solve problems not limited to an algorithm or static solution set.
	I reflect on my approach and change it when appropriate.	If the problem is not getting resolved I change my approach.
Develops Solutions	I identify the appropriate tools to solve the problem.	I use appropriate tools and develop new skills to solve problems.
	I apply the evidence to solve the problem.	I reflect on whether the solution is optimal or if I need to change based on the results.
	I use what I learn in one class/topic in a different class/topic.	I use what I learn in solving complex problems to solve other complex problems.


