## Updating Student Data

The Aeries Parent Portal is our tool for TK-12 parents/guardians to have online access to view your student's digital records, including emergency contact information, health records, attendance, and state testing reports.

On Friday, Aug. 5, you should have received an <u>email from SRCS through ParentSquare</u> asking you to login to your Aeries Parent Portal account to complete the back-to-school forms - *this is called the Data Confirmation Process*. This process allows you to confirm or update your child's information, including contact information, household income, emergency contacts, medical information and more. It also allows you to acknowledge required District policies and authorizations.

## Student Drop Off and Parking

Campus is still under construction and the student parking lot will be completed prior to the start of school. We plan to follow the same student drop off procedures as last year, with the temporary drop off being accessed through the District and Staff Lot. Please note there is NO PARKING in the staff lot, and to help the flow of traffic in the morning and afternoon all drop offs are done quickly via a carline. Please plan for a brief drop off and have conversations wrapped up. We have only one drop off for the entire school so it is essential that we keep traffic flowing. ## **Bell Schedules**

Terra Linda High shifted to a late start time last year to meet the state law passed in 2019 by California legislators requiring that public high schools begin classes no earlier than 8:30 AM.
