Master Schedule Build Monday, May 8th

This is a friendly reminder that our Master Build for the 2023-24 school year will take place this Monday, May 8th. Department Chairs will join the build during their prep periods and will spend time analyzing and troubleshooting potential conflicts. As mentioned in previous communications, Data Processor Terrie Baum has rolled our schedule from May of 2022 over and has made adjustments based upon the meeting notes that resulted from our Matrix meetings. This will allow the group to have a solid starting point from which to make tweaks, rather than start from scratch.

WASC Coordinator (Self Study February 2025)

Next year we will begin planning for our Six-year WASC review in February 2025. Essentially next year we will organize into Focus Groups (a mixture of all subject areas and both classified & certificated staff) and Home Groups (Departments, Teams). We will also begin analyzing data and updating chapters 1 & 2 in our report. The following year, 2024-25 will be the bulk of WASC meetings in which we will complete tasks and write chapters 3, 4 and 5.

As always, we will work closely with a WASC Self-Study Coordinator. This position is certificated and the WASC Coordinator is given a prep for the fall semester (0.1 FTE) the year of the visit. In addition, some hourly pay is available, up to approximately 50 hours total. Below is a little bit more about the position. This certificated position is generally assumed by a staff member with 3+ years of site teaching experience, as the report is cumulative and also includes a summary of our work the past 6 years.

The WASC Coordinator leads the site's WASC Accreditation cycle and is the primary contact, compiling all the necessary information to complete the self-study. The Coordinator will utilize the guidelines set by WASC and with the help of administration, identify a team of faculty, staff, and school leaders to write and assemble the various components of the self-study by their identified deadline. The coordinator will also train school staff on the self-study and accreditation process. The Coordinator will be available to the WASC administration and team for all communication and will lead and facilitate the WASC team visit. Expectations include the following:

- ★ Participate in ACS WASC Self-Study training session during the 2023-24 school year
- ★ Establish a general calendar for the major self-study events and a more detailed timeline of specific committee meetings and tasks to be accomplished.
- ★ Communicate with staff about the WASC Report & Process
- ★ Establish the Leadership Team, Data/Profile Group, Home and Schoolwide Focus Groups.
- ★ Write Chapter 4 (Progress on Implementation of Schoolwide Action Plan/SPSA) and assist in editing all chapters.
- ★ Assist in developing our School-wide Growth Areas for Continuous Improvement
- ★ Prepare for WASC Visiting Team 3 day accreditation in February 2025 (includes scheduling and travel details)

If you are interested in serving as the WASC Self-Study Coordinator, please let me know by the end of May. I am happy to meet with anyone interested and share more about the project.
