Award Criteria:

Scholarship	30 points

Requirements and Deadline:

The following documents must be submitted on or before Friday, April 23, 2021.

1. A completed application form submitted via e-mail as a PDF File.
2. An official high school transcript and SAT score (to be sent by the school)
3. An essay (minimum 500 words, typewritten, please) on the topic indicated on the attached application, submitted via e-mail as a PDF File.
