Dear Santiam Canyon families,

We are thrilled to announce unique summer opportunities for our students! Be on the lookout for registration forms in the coming weeks. All program options will be free to Santiam Canyon students, and paid for by a state grant we received to make up for lost instructional time due to COVID.

- **Preschool Jump!** (students that are currently preschool aged that will become Kindergarten students next fall). Dates of the program to be determined, but will occur between June 28th July 22nd, 10:00 am 12:00 pm, Monday-Thursdays.
- **Elementary Enrichment** (students that are currently grades K-5) open June 28th July 22nd, 10:00 am 12:00 pm. Mondays Thursdays.
- Middle School Enrichment (students that are currently grades 5-8) open June 28th July 22nd, 10:00 am 12:00 pm, Mondays Thursdays.
 - Students who are currently in the fifth grade will have the option to enroll in one program of their choice - either the elementary enrichment program or middle school enrichment program.
- **High School credit recovery** (students that are currently grades 9-12) open June 28th July 22nd, 10:00 am 12:00 pm, Mondays Thursdays.
 - School districts did not receive state grant funds to provide high school enrichment activities. We received funding solely for credit recovery.
- Sylvan Learning Center Tutoring Sponsorship (students that are currently grades K-11). Available June 21st September 4th, families will set their preferred schedules with Sylvan.

What is Preschool Jump?

Students will attend multiple scheduled activities to build their skills towards successfully entering kindergarten. These include social groups, structured play experiences, and tours of our facilities. <u>Transportation will be offered to all existing routes</u> for our preschool aged students.

What is Elementary Enrichment?

Students will attend multiple scheduled activities per day. <u>Transportation will be offered to all existing routes including</u> those families who are wildfire displaced.

What is Middle School Enrichment?

High School Credit Recovery

Similar to previous years, we will be offering credit recovery courses with our staff supporting students. <u>Transportation will be offered to all existing routes including</u> those families who are wildfire displaced.

Sylvan Learning Center

We will be sponsoring families to work with Sylvan Learning Center's staff for up to 11 weeks of tutoring services. Services can be provided on site in Mill City, at their Salem business office, or virtually (grades 3 - 11 only, no virtual services grades K-2). Families are encouraged to set their schedule for 2-4 hours of free tutoring services per week, no cost! <u>Transportation will NOT be offered</u> for tutoring services as families will get to set their own schedule. This opportunity is not credit bearing.
