Dear Independent Study Parent,

For those parents, whose students are enrolled in the Independent Study Program (ISP), the ISP is scheduled to begin on the first day of school, Wednesday, August 11, 2021. Parents will be notified of specific information about class meeting times, schedules, access to curriculum, meal program and other details. A parent town hall on the independent study program is scheduled for Tuesday, August 10, 6:00pm. Below is information on the ISP.

Independent Study instruction will be conducted online. Your child will be provided time for synchronous instruction will be as follows:

- TK/Kindergarten 8th grade: a minimum of 45 minutes daily (30 minutes on Wednesdays) in small student cohorts (groups)
- 9th 12th grade: a minimum of 45 minutes weekly in small student cohorts (groups)

"Synchronous instruction" means classroom-style instruction or designated small group or one-on-one instruction delivered in person, or in the form of internet or telephonic communications and involving live, two-way communication between the teacher and student. Synchronous instruction shall be provided by the teacher of record for that student.

"Asynchronous instruction" means students working independently without the teacher on assigned work.

Your child will be expected to work independently (asynchronously) without the assistance of the teacher for 20-30 hours weekly.

The ISP will operate as follows:

#### **Elementary Students**

Elementary students will be assigned to a teacher. The teacher will meet with small cohorts of students to provide synchronous instruction on a daily basis. Your student will be provided with instructional materials including textbooks and workbooks. Parents will be notified on specific details on how to pick instructional materials up from the designated school site.

**TK-6th Grade** - Daily synchronous instruction (45 minutes on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays; 30 minutes on Wednesdays) for all students throughout the school year.

# **Special Education**

Enrollment of students who have an IEP may only be enrolled in the ISP after an IEP meeting has been held regarding the ISP.

### **Technology**

Students participating in the ISP will be provided a device (Chromebook for grades TK-6th grade or iPad for grades 7th-12th). Students in the ISP will also be provided with a district-issued hot spot, upon request. Details on technology device pick up will be provided.

#### **Meal Program**

Your child will be offered school meals on a daily basis. You and/or your student will be able to pick up a school meal at any school site. The time for meal pick-up will be 12:30-1:00pm at the same locations as during the 2020-21 school year.

### Re-Enrollment Into In-Person Instruction

Parents of students enrolled in the ISP have the right to request that their student be re-enrolled into in-person learning. The district must transfer the student to in-person instruction within five (5) days of the parent request for in-person instruction. The student will be re-enrolled into in-person instruction in in-person instruction based upon class space availability and may not be returned to the student's home school or teacher.

## **Written Learning Agreements**

Within 30 days of beginning independent study, the parent, student, principal and teacher will meet to sign a Written Learning Agreement. This meeting may be conducted virtually or in-person and signed with wet or electronic signatures.
