<p>English Language Proficiency Assessments for CA</p>	<p>ELPAC measures how well students in kindergarten through 12th grade understand English when it is not their primary language. This is a paper-pencil test. PARENT GUIDE - ENGLISH & SPANISH</p>
<p>Physical Fitness Testing</p>	<p>PFT program includes 6 fitness areas and is given over multiple days. PARENT GUIDE - ENGLISH</p>
<p>Smarter Balanced Assessments for ELA & Math</p>	<p>SBAC are delivered by computer, consist of two sections: a computer adaptive test and a performance task (PT) based on the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for ELA and mathematics. PARENT GUIDE - ENGLISH & SPANISH</p>
<p>CA Science Test</p>	<p>CAST is aligned with the California Next Generation Science Standards and is a computer based test. PARENT GUIDE - ENGLISH & SPANISH</p>
<p>CA Alternative Assessment ELA & Math</p>	<p>The CAA is for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities who are unable to take the SBAC even with accessibility supports and whose individualized education program (IEP) indicates assessment with an alternate test. <p>CA Spanish Assessment</p>	<p>This is an optional assessment which our dual immersion sites have chosen to be administered since their students are receiving Spanish instruction. PARENT GUIDE - ENGLISH</p>
