8. State your telephone number.
9. Tell what you are like (use five descriptive adjectives).
10. Mention five activities you like to do.
11. Mention three activities you don't like to do.

B. In the second paragraph tell him/her the following information related to school. State the following:

12. what high school you attend (*asistir* to attend)
13. where the school is located (city, village or borough)
14. the subjects you study
15. what your favorite subject is and why
16. the name of your Spanish teacher and how s/he teaches (*enseñar* to teach: *bien, mal o regular*)
17. how many students there are in your Spanish class
18. what your class is like (two descriptive adjectives)
19. if you have a lot of homework in the class
20. if you like your Spanish class and why

C. In the third paragraph tell him/her the following information related to your family. State the following:

21. how many people there are in your family and who they are
22. the name of your mother or father
23. the age of your mother or father
24. what your mother or father is like (three adjectives)
25. the country your mother or father is from
26. one activity you like to do with your mother or father
27. the name of one brother or sister or cousin
28. his or her age
29. what s/he is like
30. one activity you like to do with him/her

D. In the fourth paragraph ask him/her at least three questions of personal identification, three questions related to his or her school and three questions related to his/her family. You can close your letter by using the very common farewell, *Un abrazo* (An embrace), and then sign your name below. Write your letter on pages 66-67.
