

**UNEXPIRED TERM FULFILLMENT**

The Board of Education has the power to fill any vacancy, by a majority vote of the whole Board, which may occur on the Board by reason of death, resignation, removal from office or from the school district, or refusal to serve, of any member or officer of the Board. The person so appointed in the place of any such member of the Board shall hold office until the next annual election of Board members. The unexpired term of the office will then be filled by election.

The Board shall have the power to call a special school district election for the purpose of filling the unexpired term of office of a member of the Board.

If the Board fails to fill the vacancy within ninety (90) days, the BOCES District Superintendent may fill it by appointment.
