

REGULAR MEETINGS

In order to perform its duties in an open and public manner, and in accordance with state law, the Board of Education shall hold regular business meetings on average twice a month.

The time, dates and place of regular Board of Education meetings shall be established at the annual organizational meeting. In the event that the day appointed for a regular meeting falls on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be rescheduled. All regular Board meetings are open to the public and shall be held in the Board offices. However, the Board will make a reasonable effort to ensure that meetings are held in an appropriate facility to adequately accommodate members of the public who wish to attend the meeting. When a meeting must be held elsewhere within the District, adequate notice as to the change must be given. Meeting facilities shall provide barrier-free physical access to persons with physical disabilities.

In addition to the members of the Board, the following individuals will regularly attend the business meetings of the Board: the Superintendent of Schools, the Assistant Superintendent, and other specified personnel as deemed necessary.
