

CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

It is the belief of the Board of Education that students must gain an understanding of and appreciation for our democratic society, the roles and responsibilities of the individual citizen, and the relationship between citizens of the United States and those citizens of other countries. To this end, and in compliance with statutory and regulatory mandates, the District will offer instruction and related activities in citizenship education. Such instruction and activities will be made available to all students in the District on a regular basis and in keeping with appropriate grade level instruction as it is practiced throughout the District.

In accordance with the above, the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag will be conducted daily in each school. In addition, the flag will be flown at half-staff on Pearl Harbor Day and on other memorial days as appropriate.
