WHEREAS, Municipal Leasing Consultants was the successful bidder with respect to the purchase and finance of the utility tractor; and

WHEREAS, the South Colonie Central School District Board of Education seeks to enter into an agreement with Municipal Leasing Consultants (“MLC”) for the lease-purchase of a Kubota Utility Tractor (“Tractor”); and

WHEREAS, the cost of the Tractor is Eighty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and Fifty Three Cents (\$84,700.53); and

WHEREAS, the amount to be financed through MLC’s lease-purchase agreement with the District is Eighty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and Fifty Three Cents (\$84,700.53) to be paid for a term of four (4) years, with an interest rate of 2.929%; and
