## INTERPRETERS FOR HEARING IMPAIRED PARENTS

The Board of Education recognizes that District parents, or persons in parental relation to a student, with hearing impairments, which prevent a meaningful participation in their child's educational program, must be afforded an equal opportunity to participate in meetings or activities pertaining to the academic and/or disciplinary aspects of their child's education. Pursuant to the Education Law of the State of New York, the District will provide an interpreter for hearing impaired parents at school-initiated academic and/or disciplinary meetings or activities including, but not limited to:

- Parent/teacher conferences.
- Child/study or building-level team meetings.
- Meetings with school counselors regarding educational progress or career planning.
- Suspension hearings or other conferences with school officials relating to disciplinary actions.

The District shall provide an interpreter for hearing impaired parents if a written request for this service has been submitted to the Superintendent of Schools ten (10) days prior to the scheduled meeting or activity. If an interpreter is unavailable, or if the parent is unable to give ten (10) days notice, the District will then make other reasonable accommodations which are satisfactory to the parents (e.g., note taker, transcript, decoder, or Telecommunication Device for the Deaf). These services shall be made available by the District at no cost to the parents.

The Board directs the Superintendent, or his/her designee, to maintain a list of available interpreters. The Superintendent, or his/her designee, shall develop procedures for notifying parents of the availability of interpreters' services and making other reasonable accommodations if an interpreter is unavailable.

Hearing impaired parents are requested to submit the corresponding form to request the appropriate accommodations.
