REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Sign up for the Summer 2022 Course is from May 23-June 20, 2022 You will need to register on the Google link: <u>https://ocs.google.com/</u><u>forms/d/1J_gfj6jJQWxjHkm6JBY57nJFlZ9iM2WRWZdYh80FRIU/edit</u> Payment of \$180.00 will need to be made to the school through MySchoolBucks. You must create an account on MySchoolBucks in order to pay for this course.
- There are 44 spots available for this course. We place 22 students per session.
- Twenty-four hours of virtual classroom instruction through Google Meet. Parents/Guardians will be given driving instruction packets to use as a guide and will need to facilitate twenty-four hours of supervised driving with the student, which totals forty-eight hours of training.

INSTRUCTOR

Mr. van der Wouden will make himself available for two separate weekly classroom session totaling 16 sessions. He will have two informational sessions for parents/guardians to attend with their teens to provide information and answer questions about the requirements of the course on Monday, June 20 at 7PM and Tuesday, June 21 at 7PM through the class portal.

COURSE FEES

The cost for the course will be \$180.00. You must make payment through My School Bucks. Participants must be sixteen years of age and have their driver's permit issued by 6/26/2022 to attend the program.

COURSE SUBMISSIONS

Along with scanning the completed packets and submitting them to the student's course /portal at the of the course (week of August 20th), you will need to turn in the original completed packets (sixteen in total) to the Colonie Central High School Main Office.

MAKE UP SESSIONS

Make up sessions MAY be offered if there are extenuating circumstances, but there may only be one or two sessions. It is required that all students attend all class sessions when scheduled (partial participation is incomplete participation). If your child does not attend all of the classes, your child will not receive an MV-285 certificate. Your child must have <u>ALL</u> 24 hours of classroom seat time credit and full documentation of 24 hours of driving time turned in prior to completion of the course or a MV-285 certificate will not be issued.

If you are taking this course and going on vacation this summer, you should plan on securing reliable WIFI access to log onto the Google Meet in order to attend the course.
