REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- CCHS student registration will be held on June 29th and June 30th 8:30-11 and 12:30-2:30. At this time school counselors will be available to answer questions and meet with parents and students.
- Non-resident students must have letter on school stationery signed by an authorized school official and their final report card.
- Fees/Tuition will be refunded only if a class is canceled due to insufficient enrollment. In general, minimum of 10 students is necessary to run a class.
- Requests to take examinations for Regents must be in writing and signed by an authorized school official.
- Science laboratory for Regents credit must be completed prior to summer school.

ATTENDANCE

Every Student is required to attend a minimum of 23 class sessions out of 25 days of instruction. Absence for special events (for example, previously scheduled vacations, sporting events, camps, court appearances, etc.) is not excusable. These absences will count as regular absences. Students who miss more than 2 classes will be dropped from class. A tardiness of 15 minutes or more will be considered an absence. Minutes being late will be added up.

SUMMER SCHOOL PARKING REGULATIONS

Licensed drivers may drive to Summer School and park on campus. Vehicles must be registered and insured. Students may park ONLY in the lot closest to Waterman Avenue. Vehicles parked in other areas may be towed.

CODE OF CONDUCT

No smoking, no vaping, possession of weapons, illegal drugs or alcoholic beverages. Violence or any disruptive behavior is not permitted at any time. Offenders will be dropped from the summer school program. Summer School is a closed campus. Students are **NOT** allowed out of the building between classes. **NO** skate boards are allowed on school grounds at any time. All South Colonie Central School District Code of Conduct regulations will be enforced.
