We are wrapping up the school year and we are thankful to be coming to the conclusion of a challenging but great year.

5. NEW BUSINESS

Ms. Gigliello attended the Press Release for Charlie's Playground at Saddlewood last week, it was wonderful. She attended the Lisha Kill DARE day which was also a great day. She attended the 2nd grade Save the Earth presentations at Roessleville in Mrs. Khan and Mrs. Jaskot's classrooms. She was invited to go mini-golfing with some of the seniors in the CCHS public speaking class and said it was a great time and a really fun experience. She attended the senior picnic, which was well attended and lots of fun. She attended the recognition ceremony at Colonie Community Connections, in which NYSSBA presented the program with a banner. She attended the iCare check presentation at the high school in which we presented a check to the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention in the amount of \$5,000. This coming Friday night is senior movie night, which is showing The Sandlot. Lots of good stuff going on! The NYSSBA convention will be held in October in Syracuse, NY, any board members interested in attending should let Amber Lanigan know as soon as possible.

Mr. Keane had the opportunity to see new officers elected into the High School PTSA yesterday. Thank you to all of them for their service and thank you to all outgoing PTA officers, it is often a thankless task that they take on. Last week he attended the softball banquet. It was a fantastic opportunity to bring the entire program together and celebrate their season. Over the past few months he has had the opportunity to travel to a number of our fellow suburban council and Section 2 schools. There are a number of facilities that set the bar for a modern campus and he is hopeful that our Vision 2025 will bring our campus up to par. One thing that stood out that South Colonie has is equity amongst male and female sports, specifically softball and baseball. At the facilities he spent time at, it was evident that more resources were put into the male sports. Each school that he attended had a scoreboard on the baseball field and that was not the case for softball. Each had permanent fences for the baseball fields, while many softball fields had temporary fencing. This is on the heels of the Suburban Council hosting a meeting day for baseball programs, but no offering for softball. This past weekend the NYS High School Athletic Association had the state baseball finals held over two days at a Division I baseball field in Binghamton, while softball played two games in one day on a baseball field that was transitioned into a softball field at a complex on Long Island. He feels it is important to share this information in this setting, as not everyone has the opportunities to see these other facilities. He is hopeful that the New York State Athletic Association, Section 2, and Suburban Council will take another look at the equity initiatives, whether it's facilities or dress code rules.


