

STUDENT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The Board of Education is authorized pursuant to the Education Law to take and hold for the use of the schools, or for the purpose of awarding scholarships, any real estate transferred to it by gift, grant, bequest, or devise, or any gift, legacy, or annuity gifted, granted, devised, purchased or bequeathed to the Board.

The Board is further authorized to apply the same, or interest and proceeds thereon, according to the instructions of the donor or testator.

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any gift, grant, bequest, legacy, or annuity given or bequeathed to the Board at its discretion.

The Superintendent will develop and maintain criteria and procedures for presenting scholarships and other suitable awards for student achievement.
