

Florida Shared School Results (FSSR)

The FSSR form enables you to “register” with and work for the Sumter County School Board (SCSB) without having to be re-fingerprinted. It allows the District that you were originally printed in to “share” your fingerprint results with SCSB and it also enables SCSB to receive notifications of any disqualifying arrest after fingerprinting (if any).

If you have been printed and approved in another Florida School District AND you are or will be working (pending contract agreement) in Sumter County Schools, you can complete the FSSR form and provide your Social Security Number OR your Transaction Control Number (TCN). Your TCN is the number generated when you were originally printed and serves as the label for your fingerprint results.

*Fingerprint results remain in the States database for five (5) years from the original print date and are purged thereafter. If it has been 5 years or more since you were printed, you will have to be re-printed.

If you DO NOT work in Sumter County Schools, your FSSR form will not be processed.
