FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT GRADUATION

- 1. How many tickets will I get? Every graduate will receive 6 tickets for seating in the gym.
- 2. <u>Does everyone need a ticket?</u> YES! Even children and babies! We remind everyone that for many of our seniors, this will be the most important night of their life, and the ONLY time they will receive their high school diploma and hear their name called out in front of 2,000 people! To have a small child crying or making noise at the exact time a name is being called, or a graduate is giving a speech, or senior chorus is singing, can never be redone, and is NOT FAIR to those parents who have looked forward to this moment for the past 18 years. **PLEASE arrange prior to graduation to have baby sitters for these children**.

PLEASE, HELP US MAKE THIS THE MEMORABLE OCCASION IT SHOULD BE!

- 3. What regalia may the graduate wear? The graduate may wear ONLY medals, cords & stoles issued by the Sumter School District. Exceptions include military enlistment stoles. You will need to show Mrs. Stewart your signed enlistment paper work to be preapproved
- 4. <u>When will we start practices?</u> We will have practice on Friday 5/23, Tuesday 5/27 and Wednesday 5/28 & Thursday 5/29. These practices will be from 9:00 a.m.–12 noon in the gym. Seniors are <u>required</u> to attend <u>all practices</u> & must be in school dress code. Roll will be taken at 9 a.m. If you are late or not in your assigned seat when roll is taken, you will stay after practice to make up your time through assigned clean up duty. Non-negotiable, no excuses

WORK & APPOINTMENTS IS NOT AN EXCUSE TO MISS THESE PRACTICES!

- 5. What are the requirements for dress at Baccalaureate and Graduation? MALES must wear a shirt with a collar, a TIE, dress black pants or new black jeans, socks and black dress shoes. FEMALES must wear a dress or dress pants with a nice dress blouse and nice dress shoes. NO FLIP FLOPS, casual shoes, etc.! PLEASE! If you do not have anything appropriate to wear or if you have any questions concerning dress for these important events, see Mrs. Stewart or Mrs. Hooten as soon as possible!
- 6. CREDIT TROUBLE? all credit recovery classes must be completed by FRIDAY, MAY 21, 2025.
- 7. **Should I have ordered a cap and gown by now?** YES! If you have not ordered a cap and gown, see Mrs. Stewart ASAP. ALL students must have a cap & gown to participate in the ceremony!
- 8. <u>Can I decorate my cap?</u> Yes, but decorations are limited to the top only & should not cause the hat to sit incorrectly or fall off your head. The design MUST be pre-approved with Mrs. Stewart or Mrs. Hooten.

Your graduation year will become a measuring year for future dates and you will want to make sure you do not do anything that may jeopardize this special time for you and for your family!
