BAC MEETING MINUTES 8/25/09

The meeting began at 7:00 in the District Office conference room.

The following members attended: Alan Sacher, Ed Hudson, Liz Morrison, Paul Killian and Mike Isernia. From the district office was Ron Sacks. There were no visitors.

The following topics were discussed:

- 1) Review and approval of the meeting minutes from 7/7/09.
- 2) There was a motion made to elect Mike Isernia as BAC Vice-Chairperson. By unanimous vote Mike Isernia was elected Vice-Chairperson.
- There was a motion made to request the BOE to remove Regine Remy from the BAC, due to lack of attendance.
- 4) The committee agreed to request the BOE to assign new members to the committee.
